

After, visit the archaeological site of Joya de Cerén, declared World Heritage of UNESCO in 1993, also called Pompeii from America, On the site, admire a pre-Columbian agricultural village of Maya



preserved remarkably intact under layers of volcanic ash, as the village was buried under the eruption of a volcano around 600 AD. Then have the lunch and visit the Volcanoes National Park.

In the afternoon, admire the beautiful Lake Coatepeque among the ten most beautiful lakes in the world. Lunch in a local restaurant with panoramic views of the lake. Then, visit the Cerro Verde National Park and take a refreshing tour through the ecological trails of the park (about 45 minutes). Cerro Verde is an inactive volcano located at an altitude of 2035 meters and a length of 500 hectares of nature. It has a cloud forest in the crater and its surroundings, with a temperature of



between 12 and 18 degrees Celsius. From here you can enjoy panoramic views of the Izalco Volcano, better known as the "Pacific Lighthouse", as the boats were lined with the glowing glow of the lava to reach the port of Acajutla, the Santa Ana Volcano. or the Ilamatepec volcano being the largest volcano in the region, and the beauty of nature in the vicinity of this national park. At the agreed time, return to the port.


