


# Valley of the moon

The Valley of the Moon, is a sector of the Cordillera de la Sal, and undoubtedly the most visited. Its mountains dotted with glitter, huge dunes, rock formations and ravines make it a true spectacle to behold, you will be able to see the Tres Marías, the Canyon, the Amphitheater and the Licanantay Viewpoint.

We will begin the tour leaving from San Pedro de Atacama towards the Salt Mountain Range in the Atacama Desert, the driest place on earth, towards one of its most picturesque points: the Valley of the Moon. The names already give a clear clue to the landscape, where rock formations modeled by erosion, sheets of salt, the Greater Dune and views that will make you feel like you are on another planet reign.

We will visit the Tres Marías, the Canyon and the Amphitheater. To end the tour, we will enjoy the sunset from the Licanantay viewpoint, where you will be able to see how the desert changes color, with large volcanoes on the horizon, offering a spectacle that will leave you speechless.

# Tatio Geyser

In this incredible destination we will visit one of the most important geothermal fields in the world "Geysers del Tatio", located at 4200 meters above sea level. It is the largest group of geysers in the southern hemisphere and the third largest in the world.

At dawn we head towards one of the entrances to the Andean highlands, where we will go directly to one of the most important geothermal fields in the world, the "Geyser del Tatio" with 80 Geysers with their smoking fumaroles, a unique spectacle in the world, where we will stay around of approximately 1 hour and 30 min, then we will enjoy a rich buffet breakfast to continue our journey back where we will enter the hills and mountains of the Andes Mountains we will contemplate important high altitude ecosystems of rich biodiversity such as the Machuca and Vados bofedales from Putana

# Altiplanic Lagoons and Piedras Rojas Viewpoint

We will pick you up at your hotel in the morning to start the trip out of the city. The tour to the Piedras Rojas and Altiplanic Lagoons will take us through important tourist places within the Atacama desert. To get to the Piedras Rojas lagoon, or Aguas Calientes salt flat as it is also known, we will have to go up in our vehicle to 3800 meters of altitude and walk for 1 hour and 15 minutes, to see these copper-colored rocks, in addition to the lagoons and salt flats around. Later, we will move to the sector of the Miscanti and Miñiques Altiplanic lagoons, where our guide will give us some explanations regarding the flora and fauna that inhabits the place. Also, we will make a stop at the Chaxa lagoon, where you can see flamingos. In the same way, we will pass through Socaire and the Tropic of Capricorn, where we will make a short stop to take pictures. Then, we will return to San Pedro de Atacama to finish our tour.

# Cejar Lagoon, Tebenquinche

## Lagoon and Ojos del Salar

Cejar Lagoon located inside the Salar de Atacama where you can float and enjoy an incredible multicolored landscape. Ojos del Salar tour, and sunset in a salt mirror called Tebenquinche.

We will start the tour visiting Laguna Cejar which has a high concentration of salt so you can float as if you were in the Dead Sea, the Lagoon has a beautiful calypso color and is surrounded by salts of various shapes. Then we go to the Ojos del Salar, two deep freshwater wells located like an oasis in the middle of the desert where we can observe its intense greenish color. We will finish with a visit to the Tebenquinche Lagoon, a nature sanctuary, a salt mirror where We will walk through beautiful trails observing the biodiversity of the environment, highlighting the importance of wildlife conservation, which is home to foxes, flamingos and microorganisms that live in extreme situations where there are only 3 places in the world, Chile being one of them.



# Rainbow Valley, Petroglyphs and Yerbas Buenas

It is located in the Rio Grande basin, about 90 km from San Pedro de Atacama, very close to the Yerbas Buenas Petroglyphs. It owes its name to the great variety of shades that can be seen on the hills of the valley. The colors show the great richness and different concentrations of clay, salts and minerals.

We start very early where we head 90 km from San Pedro towards the Rio Grande basin where we arrive at the Valle del Arcoíris. Its name is given due to the variety of colors that can be seen on the hills of the valley; earth colors, red, beige, green, white and yellow. All combined with traces of white salt and a blue sky. The colors of this sector show the ecological richness of the clay, minerals and salts. We will visit this place on a 1-hour walk there and 1 hour back, then we will move to the Salado River sector, where a small valley is formed in which we can take a walk to appreciate the landscape. After this, we will return to San Pedro de Atacama where the activity ends.

# Route of the Salt Flats

This excursion will take us to the east of San Pedro de Atacama, towards the Andes mountain range. Our first stop will be the Licancabur viewpoint, where we will enjoy our breakfast, depending on the wind conditions. If this is not possible, it will be at the next visit point, which is the Quepiaco River wetland, where we will appreciate the contrast between vegetation and mountains.

Later, we will go to the viewpoint of La Pacana, to then visit the Monks of La Pacana, huge stone pillars that rise vertically and solitary in the middle of the desert. Later, we will visit the Quisquiro salt flat, which is located at more than 4,000 m of altitude. Here we will have time to rest and enjoy the surroundings. Finally, we will pass through the Aguas Calientes salt flat, which is characterized by its different colored waters, on the way back to San Pedro de Atacama.

# Puritama Trekking

We will pick you up at your hotel to leave San Pedro de Atacama on a journey of approximately 30 minutes. We will begin our low demand trekking, of around 25 minutes through a canyon with giant cacti. We will make stops to take pictures, recognize the flora of the place and rest a bit, reaching an altitude of between 2,500 and 3,000 meters. Then, we will have views of the Puritama River, where these natural hot springs are located, originated by underground volcanic layers. After having a good time and relaxing in the hot springs, we will begin the return walking to our vehicle, and then return to San Pedro de Atacama to finish the activity with the transfer to your hotel.



# Baltinache Lagoons

Lagunas Escondidas de Baltinache, seven small turquoise lagoons with very salty water that contrast with the white of the salt flat. You can float as it happens in Laguna Cejar, it is an incredible experience that you cannot miss.

Departure from the Plaza Turistour meeting point in San Pedro de Atacama, where we will travel for an hour appreciating the beautiful desert landscapes with an infinity of colors that unfold from the rocks and salt. After this tour we will arrive at the Lagoons in which we must register and walk along a beautiful wooden path that will take us to our destination, where you can see the 7 lagoons. Bathing is only allowed in the first and last lagoon, for conservation reasons where you can dive with a recommended duration of 15 minutes. On the return we will enjoy a panoramic sunset observing the wonderful landscape of the Atacama Desert.

### Complete and detailed tour description

<p><b>Description:</b></p>	<p><i>Departure from pier, an immediate view of the centre of the city. We will begin our tour going along the south coastal road, appreciating the beautiful landscape to start our rising trip to the deserted Pampa (prairie), where we will be moving between the sun and whirlwinds.</i></p> <p><i>After an hour of travel, we will arrive to the small village of Baquedano, a settlement that keeps signs from the golden years of the white gold, as Nitrate was formerly known. Testimony of those years is the train station, with all the machinery and old steam wagons forgotten today.</i></p> <p><i>Then, we will begin our trip back to the city, appearing now along the north coastal road of the city.</i></p> <p><i>Back in the city, transfer to the historic downtown district where history, urban landscape and recreation get together. Among them: the ex-Maritime Governor´s House, the historic Pier and the Antofagasta - Bolivia Railway Museum in the ex-machine shops of FCAB, where machines, coaches, tools and six British and German locomotives can be seen, standing out a steam wagon still operative and buildings of neoclassic style.</i></p> <p><i>Return to pier.</i></p>
