HALF DAY Highlights of Buenos Aires

Elegant, old-worldly, with a touch of Paris here and a touch of London there, a dash of New York cosmopolitanism and big splash of Italian exuberance, the city also has a strong Latin America personality as well as uniquely Argentine elements.

Explore the highlights of magnificent Buenos Aires in a four-hour guided sightseeing tour. This excursion kicks off in one of the city's most significant spots: Plaza de Mayo square, the political heart of the city laid out by Don Juan de Garay in 1580 during the second founding of Buenos Aires. Continue to San Telmo neighborhood, with its cobblestoned streets, where the original porteños (Buenos Aires residents) settled in the early days. After a short drive south, stop off at picturesque La Boca, the colorful working-class port neighborhood, and walk along Caminito Street, where local artists display their artwork to the tune of tango performed on the street. Pass through Puerto Madero and see this regenerated area where redbrick warehouses have been transformed into trendy restaurants and bars before finishing the tour in Recoleta and its renowned cemetery to glimpse stunning mausoleums, the final resting place for many of Argentina's key characters.

Loved passionately and hated equally as strongly, there are many myths and legends surrounding this woman. From the power she wielded during her life to her legacy that is still living, Eva was indeed a remarkable woman. Eva did indeed make all her dreams come true.

This exclusive tour is about the history and life of Evita. Visit different places where her work was carried out: the CGT building (Labor General Confederation), Mayo Avenue, the famous balcony, the Labor Ministry, her mausoleum, Our Lady of Pilar Church, the National Library building and we will also visit the Evita Museum: A place where you will know and understand the life and work of one of the most important women of Argentina. After visiting the Museum, you will meet Santiago Regolo, the main historian and investigator of the Museum to talk and discuss about Eva's life.

HALF DAY Mysteries of Buenos Aires

Familiarize yourself with some of the most recognizable landmarks as well as history and culture in the Paris of the South on this half-day private guided city tour. Kick off at Plaza de Mayo square, the heart of the city both from a historical and political point of view, and the site of its foundation in 1580 by Don Juan de Garay.

Your next stop is San Telmo and a private visit to El Zanjón. As you go down into this beautifully restored 1830s house, enjoy long-buried architectural elements, such as a cistern, a colonial house's wall dating back to 1700 and a spectacular labyrinth of wide brick tunnels built in the mid-19th century to keep flooding at bay, offering an unusual glimpse into four centuries of Buenos Aires' urban archaeology. Also visit La Boca neighborhood, the tough port barrio and colorful working-class area. Return to the pier.

Get up close and personal to the city's deceased elite at the Recoleta Cemetery and most importantly, appreciate some local delicacies at one of our favorite neighborhood joints.

This leisurely pedal through the lusciously green parks and plazas in the north of the city will leave you feeling refreshed and intrigued.

Guests will be greeted with a welcome drink, while we get to know each other we go to the grill area to see how the fire is being prepared, to then put the meat showing him the cuts that we will use. We will tell you how long ago we received guests, why our love for gastronomy and the desire to share our rituals with them.

Our experience provides an enlightening cultural exchange over a traditional Asados, a social experience with a family in their home you're not likely to enjoy any other way. Arrive at your host home as a guest and leave as a friend. You can discuss soccer with fans, or maybe you want to learn more about the tango, the gaucho lifestyle, or your host's favorite Malbec wine. And your hosts will be just as interested in finding out more about you and where you live. This is what it's like to be an exchange student, but this is an experience that's not restricted to the young. Lunch will include appetizer, main course, dessert and coffee or tea plus white or red wine and even a taste of the ubiquitous Yerba mate tea and your tour provides roundtrip transportation.

The creators of this special tour believe that by sharing a simple meal, the people of the world may one day share peace and security based on acceptance of each other's way of life. As you sit down at the family dinner table, the differences and similarities of your respective cultures come to light as you discuss matters of the day and dreams for the future.

Your tour begins with a scenic drive through Avenida del Libertador, the most beautiful access to downtown Buenos Aires. On your way to Tigre, pass by the residential suburban neighborhoods of Vicente Lopez, Martinez, Olivos, San Isidro and Acassusso, with their calm narrow roads, yacht clubs, mansions, and plenty of trees.

For more than 100 years, the maze of rivers and channels of the Tigre Delta have been a favorite weekend getaway for "porteños" (as Buenos Aires inhabitants are called). During this relaxing excursion, you will leave the bustling city behind and enter a world that has changed little since the 1920s. Enjoy a cruise on the green labyrinth of channels and streams.

Explore the nature of the islands, enjoying the views of beautiful riverside villas, Victorian docks, English gardens, and traditional rowing and boating clubs. Return to the pier and re-board the ship.

HALF DAY Tigre Delta with lunch at Gato Blanco Type:

Tigre with its thousands of islands, streams and canals is the perfect place to disconnect and get in touch with nature.

Tigre is a riverside getaway with stilt houses, old mansions, aristocratic rowing clubs and craft shops, and the point of entry to the incredible Paraná delta with its labyrinthine network of islands and canals. It is the fifth largest delta in the world and the only one that flows into fresh water rather than into the sea. Whether you opt for the authentic experience of the local ferry buses used by islanders or for a more luxurious catamaran tour, you'll enter a labyrinthine network of canals and discover a unique way of life that seems a world away from frenetic city life.

At the Parana River, board a private motor launch and head out along the delta's waterways. You'll be surrounded by an array of colorful sights as your boat passes islands, turn-of-the-century stone mansions, English cottages, Italian villas, brightly-painted wooden shacks, yacht clubs and a flotilla of water-crafts, including canoes and sailboats.

Being the only sweet water delta in the world it possesses a very special microclimate special for many different plants, the Delta attracts new permanent and migratory birds, as new plants are incorporated.

An enjoyable lunch will be included in an Island restaurant. Gato Blanco restaurant is in one of the delta's most beautiful spots, surrounded by the greenery of the islands many floral species.

The boat will sail among these islands until it reaches Gato Blanco restaurant. You will be delighted with distinctive cuisine in a relaxing atmosphere.

Buenos Aires is home to some of the world's best polo players. This sport has a great tradition in Argentina and is mainly viewed and played by the wealthy. Set in the stunning surroundings of the Argentine countryside, this tour gives visitors to Buenos Aires the opportunity to learn more about the game, enjoy a lesson with a professional bi-lingual instructor, and watch polo club members play in an adrenaline-fueled match. No previous experience required!

Located an hour away from the city and named one of the best estancias in South America by Travel + Leisure Magazine and Forbes Traveler, Villa María is the most exclusive estancia in Argentina.

Built as a summer residence for Pereda family in 1927 by the famous architect Alejandro Bustillo, Villa María offers the perfect combination of a beautiful house and the impressive dimensions of its grounds which include a botanical garden with more than 300 species of different trees from all over the world, designed by the renowned landscaper Benito Carrasco, a disciple of Carlos Thays.

The estancia's polo manager will show us around and introduce us to the world of polo, visiting the stables, meeting the players, learning about the history of polo in Argentina and in the world, and about the rules of the game, the strategy, the horses, and much more about this traditional sport in which Argentina is ranked number one in the world.

After a delicious traditional Argentinian barbecue lunch, we will watch a private polo match exhibition with professional polo players. After the match, those who want may also take a short polo lesson with the players, learning how to ride and hit the ball at the same time.

Transfer back to the pier with brand new-found polo knowledge, skills and stories to share with friends and family back home.

<u>FULL DAY</u> <u>Gauchos of Buenos Aires – Estancia Santa Susana</u> <u>Type: Active / Family</u>

Today's focus will be on another hugely important element of Argentina's culture; the Gaucho. From the cruise you will head north towards the village of Los Cardales in the outskirts of Buenos Aires.

On arrival at the estancia we will be met by the owners who will welcome us with a typical Argentine "empanada" (meat pastie) and refreshments. Enjoy these new flavours as we are entertained by a skilful display of Gaucho horsemanship. A gaucho's life is strongly marked by his relationship with his horse.

Long after vacation travels are completed, the smell or taste of a regional food can bring back the area visited as quickly as a photograph. Whilst the "asado" (BBQ) sizzles on the open fire receiving its final touches there will be free time to stroll around the estancia; visit the museum, the chapel or take a ride on horseback or in a horse drawn carriage. Dining will be at long tables so that everyone can take part and enjoy not only the food but also the entertainment of dance and singing that will be performed during the meal. There will be a chance to try our dancing skills with one of the locals.

Enjoy a traditional tea before returning mid-afternoon to Buenos Aires.
