	One of Korea's best well-known temples on the western slope of Mt. Tohamsan, Bulguksa Temple is a monument to both the skill of the Shilla architects and the depth of Buddhist faith at the time. While most of the wooden buildings have been rebuilt over the centuries, all the stone bridges, stairways and pagodas are original. In 1995, Bulguksa Temple was added to UNESCO's World Heritage List. Afterwards, the coach takes you to a local restaurant for a Korean traditional Bulgogi (Marinated beef).				
	Relaxed and refreshed, continue with a visit to the Gyeongju National Museum, a place of compelling interest, preserves much of the Shilla heritage including magnificent gold crowns, pottery, Buddhist artefacts, and stone sculptures. The museum also houses the Divine Bell of King Seongdeok the Great, also referred to as the legendary Emuille Bell, one of Asia's largest and most resonant bells, 19 tons of bronze standing 11 feet (3.4 metres) high. Arrive at Tumuli Park, a collection of royal Shilla tombs located in the middle of Gyeongju. The park contains 20 tombs, of which Chonmachong (Flying Horse Tomb) is the most famous. Its name comes from the picture of a flying horse found painted on white birch bark when the tomb was excavated in 1974, and the tomb yielded more than 10,000. Re-board your coach one last time for the 90-minute journey back to Busan and the awaiting ship. Tour Description	Depart the pier by coach for the 30-minute drive into Busan. The UN cemetery in Busan honors UN soldiers from 16 countries and UN aids from five countries that were killed in battle during the Korean War from 1950-1953. It is the only memorial cemetery in the world dedicated to UN soldiers. While the cemetery originally held up to 11,000 graves, most of the fallen soldiers were repatriated at the request of their families, with only 2,300 graves remaining. Some notable sites and memorials include Memorial Service Hall, Memorabilia Hall, two Turkish Monuments, Greek Monument, Australian Monument, British Commonwealth Monument and two ponds. Next, visit The Busan Museum which offers seven regular exhibition rooms spread over three floors in addition to the Kiln Exhibition Hall, and the Outdoor Exhibition Hall. Opened in 1978, the museum has taken on a leading role in preserving traditional culture in Busan by obtaining a wealth of relics from strong excavation efforts, generous donations, and purchases, and by meticulous research. Experience the local atmosphere at the harbor-side Jagalchi fish market, which stretches into downtown. As a seaport, the Busan fish market offers a variety of fresh seafood, including a large shellfish section in the middle of the market. Boats unload their catches very early each morning and sell them on the spot. The sea air and fresh fish mingle with the resonant voices of the market folk to create an unforgettable experience. After, explore Gukje Market, Busan's largest and most central market area formed by merchants descended from refugees of the Korean War. The alleyways are divided into six market districts dealing in a wide variety of goods such as silk, linen, clothing, bags, glasses, and curtains. After exploring with your guide, some free time is afforded, allowing you to browse. Following this overview, re-board your coach for the 20-minute drive back to the pier



Tour Description	Located in southern part of Mt. Chiseosan, Tongdosa Temple is famous for not having any Buddhist statues in the temple. This is because the real shrines of the Buddha are preserved here. The name 'Tongdosa' was named after the belief that mankind can be saved through Buddhism. After Monk Ja-Jang brought the shrines of Buddha from Dang China, Tongdosa Temple was built during Queen Sun-Deok's reign (646). Tongdosa Temple is said to have survived numerous wars and invasions, its Beopdeung (temple candle) has never gone out, for 1,300 years. Inside, there are 35 buildings and Pagoda's, and 14 small temples in its vicinity. The main building is designated as National Treasure No.290. The temple is similar to a museum because of the numerous relics insid There are 19 local treasures and 794 local cultural properties inside the temple. In place of the Buddha statue, the Geumgang Sta behind of the main building preserves the shrines of the Buddha. Mt. Chiseosan, has a beautiful view from the temple. The severor hundred-year-old pine trees lined up from the entrance to Ilju Gate, the small drum (used when praying in front of a Buddha figur and bell, the sunset, the pond and the rocks and waterfalls behind the temple are grouped and called the 'Eight Famous Sceneries of Tongdosa Temple.' Situated on the side of a 30-meter cliff, the Oryukdo skywalk's glass floor viewing platform offers visitors a breathtaking view of Oryukdo Island. It can be found at Oryukdo Seungdumal, which is located on the southernmost point of Igidae Park's coastal walking path. The glass-floor U-shaped structure extends about 9 meters from the island, with tall reinforced glass on both sides for the safety of pedestrians. 

	After having Korean pork BBQ, you will visit to Korea's largest seafood market, Jagalchi Fish Market. After the Korean War the market solidified itself as a fish market. Most of the people who sell fish are women, so the women who sell here are called 'Jagalchi Ajumma,' 'ajumma' meaning middle-aged or married women. This market represents Busan and is famous throughout the country. If you visit you can eat fresh raw fish right at the market. Before returning the ship, you will visit Gukje Market, following the Korean War, refugees who fled to Busan set up stalls in order to make a living, and this was the beginning of the Gukje Market (gukje meaning "international" in Korean. The market stocks such a wide variety of goods, that you can find almost everything you need right here. 





Tour Description	Your journey starts from Beomeosa Temple located on the eastern side of Geumjeongsan Mountain, a famous mountain in Busan. It was founded by monk Uisang in 678, the 18th year of King Munmu (r. 661-681) of the Silla Kingdom. It is one of the three most famous temples in the Yeongnam region, along with Haeinsa Temple and Tongdosa Temple. Most of the original Beomeosa Temple site was lost during the Imjin War (1592-1598) but was restored in 1613 and has remained until now. Daeungjeon Hall is considered one of the most delicate and luxurious architectures of the Joseon dynasty. Other important sites of the temple include lijumun Gate, a three-story pagoda with four pillars built in the 9th century; pavilions, gates, and eleven hermitages. Your next stop is the most famous beach in Busan "Haeundae Beach". The white sand beach is roughly 1.5 kilometers long, over a 30- to 50-meter-wide area, creating a beautiful coastline before a shallow bay, making it perfect for swimming. People flock to Haeundae Beach every summer.
