We head off to the second wine estate for the same delicious wine tasting experience. You can buy your favourite vintage at the farm's shop before leaving. We return to Cape Town mid-day (13h00 for morning tour) or early evening (18h00 for afternoon tour) having had a real taste of the splendors of the Cape Winelands



OPTION 2: HALF-DAY CAPE TOWN CITY TOUR

Introduction: This tour explores the vibrant Cape Town City Bowl and showcases its heritage landmarks. The bustling central business district of Cape Town lies in the shadow of Table Mountain between the old suburbs of Oranjezicht and Tamboerskloof and the famous Cape Town Harbour. Modern residential developments, state-of-the-art office blocks and world-class entertainment centres have made Cape Town one of the most dynamic and cosmopolitan cities in the world. The city is rich in history and home to a multi-cultural population. This tour will give you just a glimpse of what the city of Cape Town has to offer.

Castle of Good Hope, Cape Town City Hall and Parliament Buildings



We start our half day Cape Town tour in the heart of the City Bowl and take you past the main heritage landmarks. Cape Town is the oldest city in southern Africa and is rich in history. The city was built by the Dutch East India Company and you'll see many of the historic sites that served as military, administrative and civilian facilities.

Iziko South African Museum & Company Gardens



To learn more about the fascinating history of South Africa, we visit the Iziko South African Museum. The original South African Museum was founded in 1825 and is situated in the historic Company's Gardens. The state-of-the-art Iziko South African Museum houses a vast collection of historical artefacts as well as more than 1.5 million specimens of scientific importance.

There is also a fascinating Planetarium on the property. You'll have a opportunity to stroll through the museum at your leisure and visit the gorgeous Company Gardens. The original gardens were created in the 1650s and provided the first settlers with fresh produce to replenish their food stores on the ships.

Bo-Kaap

Next stop is the vibrant village of Bo-Kaap which lies at the foot of Signal Hill. Formerly known as the Malay Quarter, it was home to the Indonesian and Asian slaves that were bought to Cape Town by the Dutch to build the city. Many of the predominantly Muslim inhabitants living in Bo-Kaap today are descendants of the original slaves. Bo-Kaap is one of the most photographed villages in the country with its brightly-painted homes and steep cobbled streets.

Signal Hill, Lions Hill, Clifton and Camps Bay

The morning or afternoon ends with a leisurely drive past Signal Hill and down Kloof Road to the beautiful seaside towns of Clifton and Camp's Bay. It's an exceptionally pretty drive and offers incredible views of Table Mountain, Lions Head, Signal Hill and the glistening Atlantic Ocean. The beaches of Clifton and Camp's Bay are Blue Flag beaches.

For those who have pre-booked Option 1, we take you to Table Mountain Aerial Cableway for a trip up to the top of the famous mountain. Otherwise, we drive back to Cape Town City Bowl along the Atlantic Seaboard passing through Sea Point and Green Point. We drop you back at your hotel or guest house mid-day (13h00 for morning tour) or early evening (18h00 for afternoon tour).

OPTION 3: HALF-DAY CAPE PENINSULA TOUR ATLANTIC SEABOARD • CAPE OF GOOD HOPE & CAPE POINT • SIMONS TOWN & THE SEASIDE TOWNS OF FALSE BAY



This half-day tour introduces you to the scenic wonders of the Cape Peninsula which is an iconic natural landmark in Cape Town. The dramatic rocky peninsula stretches 30 kilometers from Table Mountain on the northern end to the southernmost tip that plunges into the icy Atlantic Ocean. It falls within the Table Mountain National Park which is world-renowned for


outstanding biodiversity. A highlight of the tour is Cape of Good Hope Nature and Cape Point. The world-renowned reserve is a wild protected wilderness area and home to an array of antelope, the rare Cape mountain zebra and other unique animal species. It's also a haven for birds, with 250 recorded species found in the reserve. We pass through the quaint and vibrant seaside towns that stretch along the length of the Cape Peninsula, which lie nestled between the towering mountain cliffs and the glistening Atlantic Ocean.

Itinerary:

The day starts with a tour of Cape Town City Bowl and continues past the V&A Waterfront to the main suburbs of the Atlantic Seaboard. This includes Green Point, Sea Point, Clifton and Camps Bay. We travel past the Blue Flag beaches along a gorgeous scenic route with the glistening Atlantic Ocean on your right and the towering Twelve Apostle Mountains on your left.

Hout Bay, Noordhoek and Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve

We make our way to the fishing village of Hout Bay, over the spectacular Chapman's Peak Drive and into the quaint coastal town of Noordhoek. The scenic peninsula drive takes us to the magnificent Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve and Cape Point.

In Hout Bay, you have the option of taking a boat cruise to Seal Island (not included in the rate) or strolling around the popular mariner wharf and harbour where you'll make friends with the friendly seals that pop up for a pat.

At the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, we visit the famous Cape Point Lighthouse. You have the option of a short but slightly steep walk on a well-worn path to the lighthouse or you can take the funicular railway to the top. The view is spectacular and you may see whales and dolphins in the bay.

Simons Town and Boulders Beach penguin colony

We end the morning in Simons Town which is a legendary naval town overlooking False Bay. You have the option of visiting the famous penguin colony at Boulders Beach (entrance fee excluded in the rate) or spending time strolling down the historic main street of Simons Town and popping into its quaint shops and museums. We have a bite to eat and drinks (for your own account) at the Simons Town Mariner Wharf.

Kalk Bay, St James and Muizenberg

After lunch, we head back towards Cape Town and Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens travelling along the False Bay coastal route. We pass through the seaside towns of Fish Hoek, Kalk Bay, St James and Muizenberg. The streets are lined with quirky bookstores, vintage clothing shops, surf shops and a collection of popular seaside restaurants and delis. We stop along the way to wander the streets, do a bit of shopping, watch the surfers in Muizenberg, whale watching if its whale season and to take photographs of the famous colourful Victoria-era beach huts.

Stellenbosch (approximately 1 hour 45 minutes)

We leave Cape town and drive to Stellenbosch, between 30-40 minutes' drive. Your guide takes you on a tour of the historic town which is also home to one of the most prominent universities in Africa. Stellenbosch is renowned for its beautiful scenery and stately heritage buildings.

We stop at a premier wine estate and enjoy a short cellar tour and time sampling the finest wines in their collection paired with local cheese. You can purchase your favourite vintage from the wine farm.

Franschhoek (approximately 2 hours)

Our next stop is Franschhoek (meaning French corner). It's an old Huguenot village and a worldrenowned culinary destination for food and wine lovers. After a short tour of the charming town, we jump onto the Franschhoek Wine Tram.

The open-air double-decker tram takes visitors on a variety of routes. You can hop-on and hop-off the wine tram to visit the oldest and most distinguished wine estates in the valley.

The tram guide tells you more about the history of the French town and its tropical fruit and winegrowing industry. You'll sample a selection of some of the finest wines produced in the valley and can grab a bite to eat and drinks at one of the stops (not included in the rate).

Paarl and Drakenstein Prison (approximately 1 hour)

Enroute to Paarl, we take a quick detour to Drakenstein Prison (formerly known as Victor Verster Prison). This is where the great Nelson Mandela spent the last 14 months of his 27-year prison sentence. Mandela famously walked out of Drakenstein Prison a free man on the 11 February 1990. A life-size statue of Mandela has been erected at the prison.

In Paarl, you're taken on a short tour of the picturesque town before we make our way to the famous Spice Route. This popular spot is an all-in-one culinary destination.

Spice Route is located on a beautiful wine farm and offers visitors a selection wine merchants, excellent coffee shops, restaurants and delis, a craft beer brewery, shops and a children's play area. You can sample the valley's finest wines or, for a change, the best craft beer in the Cape. Shop for souvenirs or take a leisurely stroll around the gardens.

We leave Paarl late afternoon with full tummies and a real taste of the splendors of the Cape Winelands. We drop you back at your hotel or guest house between 17h30 and 18h00.
