Description of tour: Cartagena is an attractive, deeply historical city located in the region of Murcia. Enjoy a few hours exploring this Mediterranean city and learn about its history in greater depth. From the port we will head the historic district, admiring the imposing maritime façade of the city, and its stunning wall built in the 18th century that will lead us to the town hall square, where we will admire the old town hall, considered as one of the most beautiful town halls in Spain. From this point begins the Mayor Street, the main commercial artery of Cartagena, plenty of Modernist-Art Nouveau buildings, such as the Casino and the "Casa de Cervantes", considered as the greatest exponents of modernism in the city. Just to finish our journey, we will walk around the impressively restored Roman Theatre, the jewel in the crown in Cartagena, and one of the greatest archaeological discoveries in recent times.

Murcia, capital city

Description of tour: Start your tour with a 1 hour panoramic drive and enjoy expert commentary on the passing sights, towards this cosmopolitan university town that welcomes the visitor with the engaging disposition born of more than 300 days of sun per year. Upon arrival, begin your walking guided tour into the historic city core, and the Glorieta de Espana, beside Segura River, is the pulsing hub of city life. It is a pleasant, landscaped square with nice plants and terraces dating to the 18th Century and offers a tranquil place to stroll amidst numerous diversions that pique your interest. Marvel at the imposing Cathedral of Murcia, which was built in the Castilian Gothic style for 400 years and its intriguing blend of Renaissance, Baroque, Rococo and Neoclassical styles. Other noteworthy buildings in the Cathedral Square, are the colorful 18th century Bishop's Palace and the Town Hall with its -modern- controversial extension built in 1999 by Spanish architect Rafael Moneo. Your next stop is at Murcia's Casino, not a gambling hall, but one of the most emblematic buildings in the city, located on Traperia street. It displays a mix of the main art influences that coexisted during the second half of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century. The dance hall and the English library are some of the rooms that will for sure catch your attention. Enjoy some free time in the city centre.

They feature architectural elements such as wrought iron balconies, floral details, ceramic decorations and sensual ornamentation. After pausing for a signature local coffee liqueur known as an Asiatico. Panoramic bus ride through Cartagena watching the city founded by Asdrúbal in 229 BC. First of all we will transport us to enjoy the views of the Mar Menor of great landscape value.

Are you ready for savoring the two shores of Cartagena city and countryside?

A panoramic tour around the city will show you the importance of the protected bay, including a view of the sea on the past and nowadays. From the Mediterranean to the Mar Menor, a huge lake whose water properties brought the attention of many civilisations since the Middle Ages. Some of the traditional facilities will help to know how people enjoyed healthy thalasso baths, adding nowadays a wide range of food options. Wines of the region and traditional recipes will meet your expectations. We will be delighted by La Encarnación's cuisine which is based on fresh local products. On this tour we will approach to many typical Spanish flavors. Gastronomy is history, part of the daily food is the result of the human evolution in each region. The original products are many times consequence of an invasion, a discovery or an ancient political and commercial relationships.

We will start tasting an appetizer called "Tapa". In Spain means a small portion and regularly is free of charge ordering just a drink.

In the Region of Murcia the famous Tapa is called "Marinera" "sailor" a dry biscuit called rosquilla is the base and the Russian salad on top (boiled veg and tuna mixed with mayonese) covered by an anchovy.

During lunch we will continue approaching to the Spanish and Murcian traditional food with Iberian products (One of the most popular Spanish national treasures) "Ham, Chorizo, Lomo, etc..."

Manchego Cheese from the region of la Mancha, "Land of Don. Quijote" will also accompany our most popular delicatessen.

Nowadays, Spain is not only known as an international destination for holidays but also for the influences of other cultures and their gastronomy.

Another dish to taste it will be Scrambled eggs with salmon which is a typical northern Europe dish.
