**Activities:** Bandia Reserve and A glimpse of Dakar which is a 7 hours package that includes

- 1) Explore the Bandia Park where you will spot African wildlife in their natural habitats – such as giraffes, buffaloes, rhinos, a variety of antelopes, zebras, monkeys, crocodiles, tortoises and more
- 2) See the main historic sights of the city\*\*This is subjected to traffic and time to be spent in Bandia Reserve
- 3) Discover the Kermel Market and its variety of high-quality produce and goods

**Expected travel dates:** MAR 2025 | **Suggested Departure Times:** 8:30am - 3:30pm



#### **Tour details: Bandia Reserve**

We will pick you up at 8:30am at the port, and the expedition leader will have a company ETA Company Placard to recognize them. You will be picked by your van/bus/coaches depending on the number of signed participants on the tour. The transfer takes about 1hr 30 minutes . Upon arrival depending on the booked slot, you will take a maximum of 2 hrs game driver in a reserve that covers 1000 hectares, where you will spot African wildlife in their natural habitats – such as giraffes, buffaloes, rhinos, a variety of antelopes, zebras, monkeys, crocodiles, tortoises and more. Lunch will be served around 12:00 PM at the Bandia park restaurant before driving park to the Dakar

#### **Grand Mosque**

Proceed to the Grand Mosque of Dakar, a wonderful example of Islamic architecture. You will stop here for a photo shoot

**Presidential Palace**

Visit the Dakar Senegal Built for the former French Governor, it now serves as the official home of the current sitting president

**African Renaissance Monument**

A striking monument of 21st century Africa, it offers a panoramic view of the city of Dakar. You will have an opportunity to take pictures and view the city landmarks from the monument vantage point.

**Kermel Market**

Before heading to the port, you will market. This is a must-visit, one of the best of Dakar's markets! In a beautiful circular building, the fish traders have their place in the center. Then comes butchers in the next circle, vegetable and fruit dealers outside there together with florists. Outside the building, you will find typical African souvenirs such as jewelry, masks, and sculptures. We join your drive at 3:15 to drive you back to the port where will drop you off at around 3.30p, pm to the port or accommodation point

#### **Tour Detail: Goree Island**

Upon pick up at the port at 9.30 am, you will head to catch a ferry to Proceed to the Goree island, The ride of the ferry takes 20 mins. The island is best known for its role as a strategic trading centre for the transatlantic slave trade. Its most famous building, the House of Slaves, was, by some accounts, the first stop for around 20 million African enslaved workers. Explore the slave house Museum, some colonial sites, and stroll to the nice island before dropping heading back to Dakar

#### **Grand Mosque**

Proceed to the Grand Mosque of Dakar, a wonderful example of Islamic civilization and architecture. You will stop here for photo shoot

#### **Presidential Palace**

Visit the Dakar Senegal Built for the former French Governor, it now serves as the official home of the current sitting president

#### **African Renaissance Monument**

A striking monument of 21st century Africa, it offers a panoramic view of the city of Dakar. You will have an opportunity to take pictures and view the city landmarks from the monument

Pass By: Dakar Railway Station, Dakar-Plateau, Dakar Senegal the statue of des tirailleurs and the Mali market Pass By: Grand Mosque of Dakar, Dakar Senegal Taking pictures and telling them about the grand mosque of Dakar history Stop At: Cathedrale du Souvenir Africain de Dakar, Boulevard de la République, Dakar 12500 Senegal Will explain them about the history of the cathedral. Proceed to the African Renaissance Monument, Dakar, Senegal Visiting the museum inside the statue of renaissance. Continue to Musée Civilisations noires, Dakar-Plateau, Dakar, Senegal We will also visit the museum and listen to the guide telling the story.
