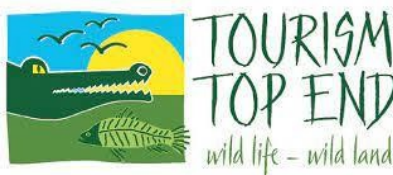

Your experienced and knowledgeable local guide will treat you to the best of Darwin's food scene. Join us for lunch or dinner on an escorted 3.5 hour easy walking tour. Chefs and staff present at least a dozen tasting plates (degustation) with an emphasis on local produce and Aboriginal bush foods. Our rotating roster of dining places includes many of the city's most award-winning restaurants. Coffee, tea and standard soft drinks are included.

During the short walk we'll also show you cultural and historic landmarks and Darwin's vibrant street artworks. Download the free 'Darwin Street Art' app for [Apple](#) or [Android](#) devices to see cool, futuristic augmented reality art. Your guide also carries an iPad if you want to view it on a bigger screen.

What's the food like?

You'll enjoy a wide variety of gourmet dishes. We cater for dietary preferences including vegetarian, pescatarian, gluten-free, allergy-related and others. Below is a wide selection from several of the restaurants on our tours indicative of some of the gourmet dishes you can expect on a typical tour. Selections may vary from tour to tour, but we'll serve you more than 12 different dishes. Text in **bold** indicates produce that has been sourced locally, from the Northern Territory, or Aboriginal bush foods.

- Pepperberry loaf, olive oil and **saltbush** dukka
- Miso tempura **crocodile**, **mango** and **green chilli sauce**, edamame and radish
- **Kangaroo** fillet, **quandong** and star anise spiced beetroot puree and braised **pineapple** chutney
- **King oyster mushroom** scallop, pumpkin puree, teriyaki sauce and wild popped rice
- Green **papaya** salad
- Berber spiced **kangaroo** with tomato jam
- Whole chargrilled gold band **snapper** with cashew sauce
- **Barramundi** fillets in **turmeric**, **lemongrass**, fresh **curry leaves**, **coconut**
- Char grilled beef in local **betel leaf**
- Garlic **mango prawn** beetroot salad
- Salt and pepper marinated **crocodile**
- Garlic **kai lan** stir fried with oyster sauce
- Chargrilled NT **banana prawns**
- **Eggplant** with a sweet and sour dressing
- **Kang kong** stir fried with special sauce
- **Pandan**-infused custard with black rice, brown sugar crumble and sesame meringue
- **Mango** vanilla bean cheesecake, **rosella** and strawberry gum coulis, toasted **coconut**

Our location

We operate gourmet food tours in the beautiful city of Darwin, the capitol of Australia's Northern Territory. A small tropical city of 120,000 people, Darwin is closer to Bali than it is to Brisbane. Our culinary history is influenced by Aboriginal, Asian and European cultures.



Our meeting place

Most tours meet at PepperBerry Restaurant at the Hilton, 32 Mitchell Street, Darwin City. Your guide will meet you there.

About the walk

This is a relaxed walking tour on level and paved walkways, all wheelchair accessible. The average walking distance is under 1.4 kilometres, broken into short walks between restaurants. Our tours generally finish about a kilometre from where they started. If the weather is poor we'll provide transport.



Tours operate in a compact walking area as indicated above. Many of our tours finish at Darwin's vibrant Waterfront Precinct, below.



What to wear

Please dress smart casual. You may want to wear a short-sleeved collared shirt and shorts in Darwin's tropical climate, but no singlets or thongs please. Comfortable covered walking shoes are recommended.



We cater for special diets

We cater for dietary preferences including vegetarian, pescatarian, gluten-free, shellfish-free, allergies, and others. When you make a booking there's a space where you can write in your dietary preference, then confirm this with your guide at the start of your tour. Kindly note we are unable to cater for diets that are onion-free, vegan, halal, or kosher.

What drinks are available?

Standard soft drinks, coffee and tea are included in the price of most of our food tours. See tour for details. Alcohol is not included in the price of our tours, but if you'd like to purchase alcohol, you can do so at most of the restaurants on our tour.

What are restaurant amenities like?

All tours and restaurants are wheelchair-accessible. Most of the places we visit are air conditioned. Washrooms are available at all locations. Eating areas are non-smoking areas. Smoking areas are usually available nearby. We stay at restaurants for only 40 minutes before moving on to the next restaurant on the tour.

Booking terms and conditions

1. Minimum and maximum guest numbers

We can host from 1 guest up to a maximum of 15 guests per tour. We have the capability to host several tour groups concurrently. All ad hoc group bookings are subject to availability and on a request basis only. Please contact us directly to discuss your specific group needs. email: info@darwingourmettours.com

2. Tour availability

Gourmet Lunch tours are from 11:30 to 15:00. Gourmet Dinner tours are from 17:30 to 21:00. Our website lists [days of operation](#). Other days available on request. All tours operate rain or shine, subject to availability.

3. Ad hoc private tour availability

Ad hoc private tours require a minimum of six guests to operate. If you book six guests 24 hours in advance, we can host a private tour any time. If you have fewer than six guests we can conduct a private ad hoc tour for two to five people, at an additional charge. See our rates chart for pricing.

4. Cancellation, amendment and refund policy

If you cancel or amend a booking 72 hours or more before the start of your tour you will receive a full refund. If you cancel or amend a booking fewer than 72 hours before the start of your tour you will be charged 50% of your total cost. If you book a tour but we cancel the tour due to insufficient bookings or for any other reason, you will receive a full refund and the option to book another tour at a discount. If you cancel a tour due to Covid-19 you will receive a full refund.

5. Block-out period

We operate 365 days a year but all bookings are subject to availability.

6. Children

Girls and boys of all ages are welcome to join tours. Those aged 6 to 16 years old inclusive pay the listed Child's price. Those aged under 6 years old eat free of charge.

7. Accessibility

All tours are wheelchair-accessible. Guides are happy to assist guests who experience limited mobility or require assistance.

8. Health and safety

We comply with all directions of the Northern Territory Department of Health, including those regarding Covid-19. When you book a tour, we ask that you provide the name and contact information for each person in your group. You don't need to check in at restaurants because we provide them with your contact information from our manifest (when required). Contact us before joining the tour if you are feeling unwell. If you have a medical condition we should be aware of, please tell us when you book the tour.
