Tour Summary:

The Republic of Djibouti, although located in the dry horn of Africa, is home to several National Parks and protected areas. The country is a paradise for nature lovers, where over 800 species of plants, including olive trees and boxwood, 40 kinds of reptiles, and 360 types of birds, some critically endangered, thrive in their natural habitat. You will be picked up from your city hotel or airport at the start of the tour. Head to Primary Forest, a dense natural forest situated almost 2000 meters above sea level, where you'll find age-old Juniper trees and Strangler figs. Around the area rests the retreat and summer house of the former governor, which features a breathtaking viewing point of the Gulf of Tadjoura. After your upland adventure, head down to Sable Blancs Beach, the most beautiful beach in the nation, replete with corals and tropical fish. Here you can cool down and laze on the beach, enjoy a refreshing dip in its waters, and see the underwater world while snorkeling.

Lac Abbe is situated on the border of Djibouti and Ethiopia, a lake that stretches six miles in width and is covered in clusters of massive, steam-blasting limestone chimneys. Unlike the usual lake, Abbe's dry land absorbs the water, and the area is a vast landscape of salt flats. Travel from Djibouti to Lake Abbe, and upon arrival, be welcomed by the chimneys stretching as high as 150 feet into the air. Despite the hot and hellish climate in the Afar Depression, you can expect to see nomadic shepherds, flocks of flamingos, antelopes, and gazelles around the area. Your knowledgeable local guide will also tell you more about the area's fascinating geology as you go on a walking tour. Your Lac Abbe or Lake Abbe tour concludes with a transfer back to the port.



Djibouti, the port city and capital of the Republic of Djibouti, lies in northeast Africa on the Gulf of Aden at the southern entrance to the Red Sea. Built on three-level areas linked in jetties, the city combines old and modern architecture. On this tour, you will explore the city's capital and learn more about its colorful history and rich culture. Start by visiting the European and the Arab quarters, which are adjacent to each other. In the city's European Quarter, you can expect a mix of French colonialism and Moorish architecture. You will also find various stores selling all sorts of local items. Continue to Place

Mahmoud Harbi or Place Rimbaud, where the city's most iconic building and Djibouti's most important landmark is: the mosque. Then, proceed to the African Quarter, an enormous sprawl of tin-roofed huts lined up on barren streets. Located in Tadjourah and rimmed by white crusts of salt on every edge, Lac Assal, or Lake Assal, is the third saltiest body of water in the world - even more saline than the Dead Sea. Also known as the honey lake, Lac Assal is a crater lake that sits atop the Great Rift Valley. Several dormant volcanoes and lava fields surround the lake, and the locals have used the location to harvest salt. Upon arrival, be captivated by the breathtaking views of the turquoise blue lake contrasted against the brilliantly white salt fields. From the smallest to the biggest, rock in and around the lake is coated in a thick layer of salt. Before the tour ends, make sure to check out the souvenirs sold by the locals, which include salt crystals, salt-encrusted rocks, and other trinkets you won't find anywhere else but in Lac Assal.

Hop on a boat from the city port and travel for about 30 mins to Mask. With your snorkelling gear, jump into the water and have a chance to see all the fish species you can imagine: surgeonfish, angelfish, parrotfish, napoleon, barracuda, and if you're lucky, you may even spot some sea turtles. Then, head to Moucha Island, where Sheraton Beach is a perfect spot to chill and enjoy a picnic. While in Moucha, you may also explore its mangrove forest, which serves as a shelter for fish and other organisms looking for food and protection from predators. Head back to the city at the end of the day where yu will dropped back to the port.

These vast animals feed almost exclusively on plankton and small fishes and pose no threat to humans. Aside from the whale sharks, Plage d'Arta is also an excellent spot for diving and snorkelling because the area has magnificent corals and many colourful fish. You will then head back to the port after the tour.
