SOUTHERN MARTINIQUE BY BOAT



Depart from the pier and sail along the coast of the South of Martinique. See Ramier Islet that rises at 124 feet (38 m) above the sea and Bat Cave, one of the sights of the island which houses a colony of bats. Than take time to visit, Anse Dufour with its many fishing boats, Anse d'Arlet, Grande Anse et its famous beach.

ST. PIERRE AND RUM DISTILLERY



Travel through the rain forest to one of the best distilleries of Martinique, with a stop at Balata Church, an exact replica of the Basilica of the Sacred Heart (Scare-Coeur) in Paris' MONTMARTRE district, but with a spectacular view of Fort de France and the bay.

Visit of the DEPAZ rum distillery, with an explanation about process of production. You will have the opportunity to taste the famous Agricola rum of Martinique.

SAINT PIERRE: After a drive of about 15 minutes from the Distillery, you will arrive in the most famous place in Martinique, even if it is for tragic reasons. The town was destroyed by a volcano eruption in 1902 killing 30 000 people except a prisoner "CYPARIS" who was in an underground jail. Saint Pierre is now France 101st "City of Art and History". You will visit the Volcanological museum.

Then you will return to Fort De France passing through fishing villages like Le CARBET, where Christopher Columbus landed in 1502 and where Paul GAUGUIN lived in 1887, Bellefontaine well known for the House-shaped like a boat, or SCHOELCHER named for a famous 19th-century abolitionist who fought for the independence of slaves in the French West Indies.

KAYAKING MANGROVES ADVENTURE



Departing from the ship by bus, you will go to Pottery Village at Trois Ilets, where your kayaks will wait for you.

There, your will receive a brief Kayak and safety lesson. Paddling from the islet, you will penetrate inside a natural mangrove where you will appreciate the peaceful and atmospheric area. You will discover with your guide this natural environment where there is the aquatic fauna reproduction. The calm water will be ideal for novices also. During the paddle under a vegetation umbrella in the mangrove, your escorts will relate the area's quiet benefit of this nature.

On the way back, you will stop at Pointe du Bout beach, relaxing and having a refreshment.

FORT DE FRANCE AND ITS BOTANICAL GARDEN



You will board your open-air bus to discover Fort De France. Formerly Fort Royal, Fort de France is today the administrative capital of the island, you will enjoy your drive through down town learning about monuments with your guide.

After a drive of 20 minutes you will stop to visit a mini replica of the Sacred Heart Basilica of MONTMARTRE in Paris, built in 1925. Situated on the height of Fort de France, it offers a panoramic view of the city and its bay.

Continuing your trip, you will arrive at that garden which has been opened to the public, after 20 years of collection of flowers and plants and of ground preparation by the owner Mr Jean Philippe THOZE a botanical and landscape gardener. You will walk under the trees, you will discover the multitude of botanical plants and flowers harmoniously placed which will make you dream of. If you want, you will have the opportunity to discover this paradisiacal place by a suspension bridge. Seen from above, the garden is even more exceptional, the views on Fort De France Bay and Pitons of Le Carbet have to be immortalized by your camera.

BEACH AND TURTLES



You will board a motor catamaran equipped with a submarine vision. You will cross the Flemish bay and learn about its history. Fort de France bay has been recently classified as one of the most important hotspots of biodiversity. After a fast crossing of the bay, you will sail along the coast closed to the RAMIER islet, the Bat Cave, and a wide panel of the marine and ground biodiversity will be offered to you. Then you will pass Salomon Cape to reach a beautiful white sand beach called Grande Anse. The group on the boat will be shared on 2 parts, 1 for the beach and the other for watching turtles by the submarine vision on board, and switched at the end. You will have the opportunity to meet the marine turtles. This specie does not stop growing du to the drastic measures to protect them. You will enjoy the time relaxing yourself on the beach, and swimming. On your return way, you will taste some local little cakes, local fruit juice, rum punch with a traditional musical ambiance






Time to come back to Fort de France, but not before a refreshing stop at a waterfall called Saut Gendarme.

Moreover let yourself be amazed by our beautiful hummingbirds! Realize an amazing experience: a discovery of the garden seen trees through a walk on bridges suspended to giant mahoganys.

For the second half of the tour, more than just a distillery, a visit to Habitation Clément offers the opportunity to discover the techniques and process of rum making, and finish by a tasting! Top off the experience: immerse yourself in the memory of yesteryears as you visit the famous Colonial House, contrasting with the modern style of the pieces of art in the garden.
