General information

- ❖ Brazil is a very hot country; therefore; we suggest weather appropriate clothing such as sun cap, sunglasses, sunscreen, light clothes and comfortable walking shoes for all excursions.
- ❖ We have included bottle/cup of mineral water inside vehicles for every excursions.
- ❖ Tour sequence may vary.
- ❖ We have included some special gifts/ items in select excursions, and we have highlighted them separately.
- ❖ Transportation capacity in Brazil:
 - Van – maximum capacity 10 seats
 - Micro buses – maximum capacity ranges between 25 and 30 seats
 - Buses – maximum capacity ranges between 40 and 46 seats
- ❖ Bilingual guides – we are considering English as main language for all excursions.



We have reserved chairs and sun umbrellas for each passenger. NO private space can be reserved at the beach, since beaches in Brazil are public by law, but we have a separate area for our clients.



Please note that this tour is not suitable for guests with walking difficulties. Wheelchair access and infrastructure for people with disabilities, are limited in Brazil, including on buses and many tourist attractions.



This tour includes moderate walking /standing, which involve navigating some steps.

Fortaleza

Half-day City Tour of Fortaleza

- Buses depart from the pier heading towards Futuro Beach, passing by the historic Mucuripe lighthouse, making a brief stop at the stone pier for photos opportunities and continuing through the scenic new residential area of Aldeota.
- The tour then proceeds to downtown Fortaleza for a visit to Sé Cathedral. The routes include a drive through the city. Passing by the cultural center “Dragão do Mar”, Iracema beach, the Metallic bridge, a 20-minute stop at Handicraft market, Meireles beach and finally returning to the pier.
- Tour duration: 03 ½ to 04 hours
- Maximum of clients: 500

- Buses depart from the port at the scheduled time. We will pass by the old Mucuripe Lighthouse; there will be no stop and head towards Futuro Beach. We will continue along Av. Santos Dumont, Av. Desembargador Moreira, Praça Portugal, the Mausoleum of former President Castelo Branco, Av. Historiador Raimundo Girão, Mercado Central, Catedral da Sé, 1st stop - 15 minutes duration, Praça dos Leões, Parque das Crianças, Av. Duque de Caxias, Teatro José de Alencar, 2nd stop - 20 minutes duration.
- Afterwards, we will head to the other side of the city center, where we will arrive at the Centro de Turismo, 3rd stop - 45 minutes duration - shopping stop.
- We will continue along Av. Leste Oeste, Forte de Nossa Senhora da Assunção, Centro Cultural Dragão do Mar, the neighborhood of Praia de Iracema, Ponte das Pedras, 4th stop - 15 minutes duration.
- Afterwards, we will drive to Av. Beira-Mar, where we will make a stop for lunch at Restaurant "Rasco," offering an all-you-can-eat barbecue service, including mineral water, soft drinks, fruit juices, beers, and caipirinhas.
- Following lunch, we will depart from the restaurant to continue our tour. We will have the final stop at Sorveteria 50 Sabores, including 1 scoop of typical ice cream per person, before returning to the port of Fortaleza.

Half Day Cachaça Museum

Buses leave the port and head straight to the Cachaça Museum, located in the municipality of Maranguape, which is 70 km from Fortaleza. The estimated travel time is approximately 1 hour.

Upon arrival, you will be warmly welcomed and guided through the museum, where you can explore the rich history of sugarcane brandy, brought to Brazil by the "Teles" family from Portugal. The museum tour typically lasts around 50 minutes.

Following the museum visit, passengers will have the opportunity to participate in a Cachaça tasting experience.

After departing from the museum, we will pass by Futuro Beach on our way back to the port of Fortaleza.

As a special treat, each client will have the chance to enjoy a Cachaça tasting.

Cumbuco Beach with Buggy Ride



Buses depart from the pier heading to Cumbuco Beach, which is located 35 km from Fortaleza on the west coast of the state of Ceará. The transfer takes approximately 50 minutes. Cumbuco Beach is a stunning destination known for its white sand dunes and coconut groves. We have a local restaurant designated as our meeting point.

Upon arriving at the beach, the group will be divided for the famous buggy ride through the dunes, a tour that lasts approximately 50 minutes. Each buggy can accommodate up to 2 passengers along with a Brazilian professional driver. Following the thrilling buggy ride, you'll have free leisure time to enjoy the beach. Afterward, we'll return to the pier

Departures from the harbor are scheduled every 30 minutes, providing transportation from the harbor to Futuro Beach and back from Futuro Beach to the harbor. Futuro Beach is situated just 10 kilometers from the port, and each journey is expected to take approximately 20 minutes.

To ensure a smooth operation, you will require one coordinator at the harbor and another coordinator on the beach.

For your convenience, a beach hut is available for passengers, equipped with restrooms, restaurants, bars, and beach chairs. The beach hut will be open daily from 10 am to 5 pm.

Please note that all passenger expenses must be settled directly by the passengers at the beach hut.

Departures from the harbor are scheduled every 30 minutes, providing transportation from the harbor to Av. Beira Mar and back from Beira Mar Avenue to the harbor. Beira Mar avenue is situated just 2 kilometers from the port, and each journey is expected to take approximately 10 minutes.

To ensure a smooth operation, you will require one coordinator at the harbor and another coordinator on the avenue.

The Beira-Mar Craft Fair is a market for handicrafts and other rustic items that takes place on the boardwalk of Beira Mar Avenue in the city of Fortaleza. The fair happens every day of the week. “The Beira-Mar Craft Fair will be open daily from 5 pm to 11:00pm
