Hollywood Road is the perfect place to find wood-block prints, china, porcelain, Buddha statues, snuff and perfume bottles, Chinese furniture and a host of other items.</p> <p>The lively district of Soho is home to the Mid-Levels Escalator, currently the Guinness World Record holder of the world's longest covered escalator. This one-direction escalator carries almost 34,000 people daily and is 800 metres long. Soho is an area packed with bars and restaurants and is a particular hot spot for nightlife.</p> <p>The huge, grey building of the Central District Police Station features Doric-style columns and stands as a testimony to Hong Kong's colonial heritage.</p> <p>The compact narrow alleys of Li Yuen Street East and West are packed with stalls and shops selling casual wear, leatherwear and knick-knacks to local housewives, visitors and commuters alike.</p>

Tour Description	<p>A unique opportunity to visit a side of the city which is often unseen.</p> <p>Your first stop will be at the Sam Tung Uk Museum which provides an authentic and fascinating insight into the lifestyles of villagers in the New Territories before modern development completely transformed this once entirely rural area.</p> <p>The next visit is to Chuk Lam Sim Yuen (Bamboo Forest Monastery) which is one of the most impressive temple complexes in Hong Kong. The temple was completed in 1932 when, legend has it, Tou Tei, the earth god, told an elderly monk to build it. The temple contains three of the largest golden Buddhas in the territory.</p> <p>An unexpected delight in this district is the Wishing Tree outside the Tin Hau Temple in Lam Tsuen. An ancient banyan, it is festooned with red and gold incense papers and other offerings thrown into its branches by the faithful - and the hopeful. Adjoining trees, thought to be equally lucky also bear their share of colourful wishing papers. According to tradition, at Chinese New Year, people pray for year-long peace by scribbling their dreams on slips of red paper tied to an orange with string. They then toss them into the air and if the lucky paper charm catches on the tree, it is said that the wish will be granted.</p>

Hong Kong is one of the world's great movie capitals, and the Avenue of Stars is the island's answer to Hollywood's famous Walk of Fame. The Avenue also features a towering Hong Kong film awards statuette and a life-size statue of the legendary Bruce Lee. Temple Street night market is lined with row after row of brightly lit stalls hawking inexpensive goods. The wares range from clothing, jewellery and accessories to CDs, electronic gadgets and luggage.</p> <p>Essential information. There is approximately 2 hours' walking on this tour. A delicious buffet lunch will be served in the Tower Revolving Restaurant on the 60th floor where you can take in the stunning views as you dine.</p> <p>Finally, visit A-Ma Temple, built in the 15th Century by Chinese fishermen as a shrine to the goddess A-Ma this is considered to be Macau's oldest temple. The temple consists primarily of 4 halls which sit in perfect harmony with the natural environment. In 1993, the Hong Kong Government took the decision to conserve and develop the fort into the present day Museum of Coastal Defence. Inside the museum, there is a permanent exhibition with exhibits from the Ming and Qing dynasties, the British period, the Japanese Invasion and the period after Chinese sovereignty resumed over Hong Kong.</p> <p>Essential information: There is approximately 3¼ hours of walking over uneven ground on this tour.
