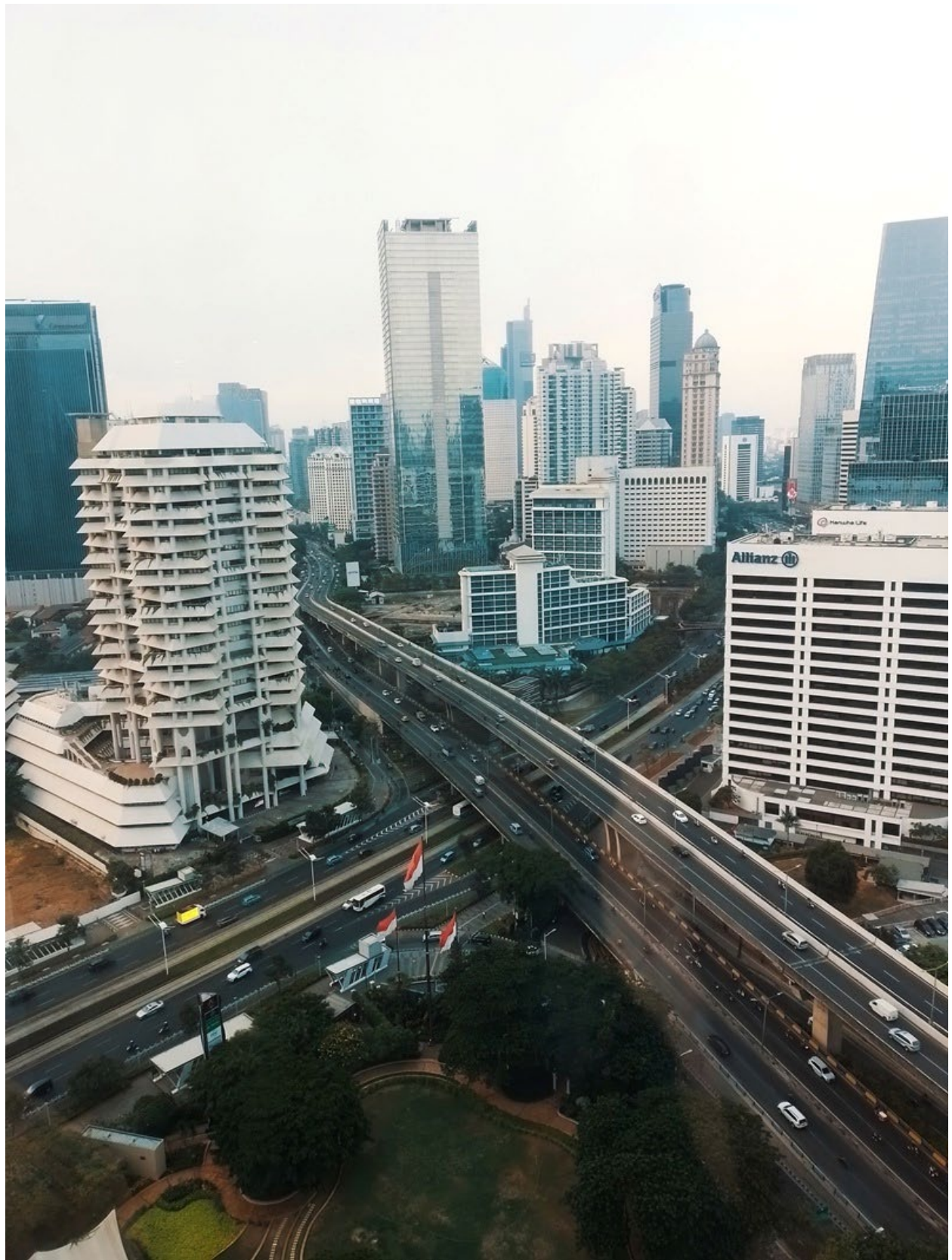

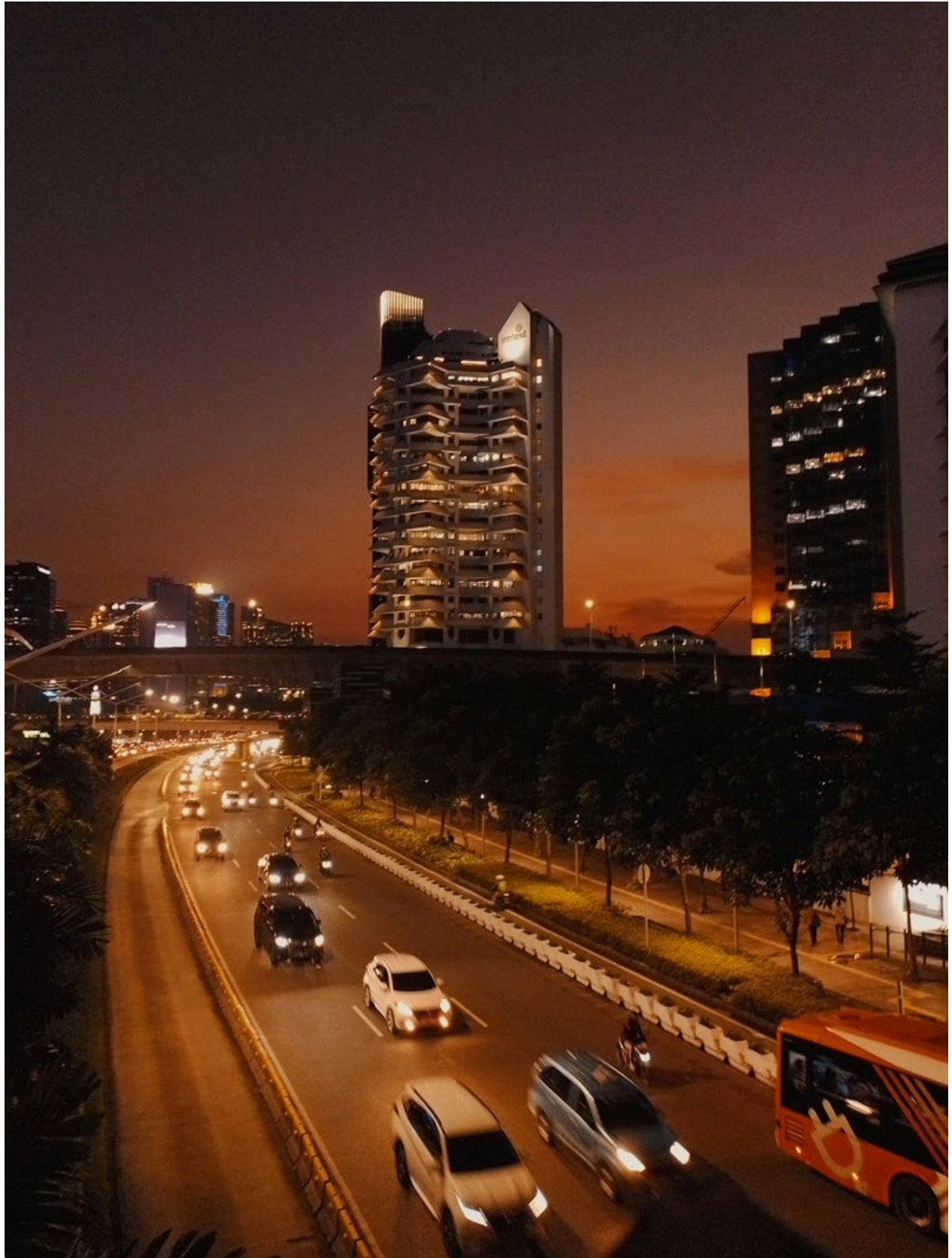

# 1)JAKARTA CITY TOUR 1 [HALF DAY]

This tour will take you to see must-visit places in this capital city of Indonesia. The National Monuments as the icon of Jakarta, and you will get to know more about Indonesia history at National Museum. The old city is the home of colonial buildings built by the Dutch. You will also have a nostalgic visit to Sunda Kelapa Harbor, the traditional harbor where wooden boats transport goods to and from this harbor.

## NATIONAL MONUMENT:

Built in 1961 with the height of 132 meters tall, Monas becomes the symbol of Indonesians' struggle against colonization. The top of the monument is decorated with 14.5 meters bronze flame and coated with 32-kilogram gold leaf. The monument has museum situated in its pedestal where diorama about Indonesian struggle to gain independence.

## ISTISQAL MOSQUE

This grand and iconic mosque was opened in 1978. Istiqlal name derives from Arabic word means "Independence". It is one of the biggest mosques in the world in term of worshipper capacity. It is situated nearby Jakarta Cathedral and Immanuel Church. In 2021 a tunnel connecting the cathedral and the mosque has finish, the tunnel is called "Terowongan Silaturahmi" or "Friendship Tunnel" to facilitate easy parking for both place of worship.

## KOTA TUA (OLD BATAVIA)

The old town when the town inhabitants was 150,000 unlike the modern-day Jakarta. The city has rich of art deco style building. Now buildings are functioned as museums, restaurants and cafes. The main square of the area is called Fatahillah square, named after Jakarta local hero. There are museums clustered in Kota Tua : Jakarta History Museum, Maritime Museum, Bank Museum and even a Puppetry Museum.

## SUNDA KELAPA HARBOR:

Sunda Kelapa Harbor is city's oldest harbor and serves inter-island ships. It is situated at the estuarine of Ciliwung River. It was the main port of Pajajaran Kingdom (13-16<sup>th</sup> Century). Spice, especially pepper, was the main commodity of Sunda Kingdom. Trades came for Europe, China and India for this spice. Today this harbor accommodated phinisi boat, Now Sunda Kelapa is state-own harbor and still function as domestic cargo harbor, where we can see phinisi, a traditional two masted wooden sailing ship serve domestic freight in the archipelago.
