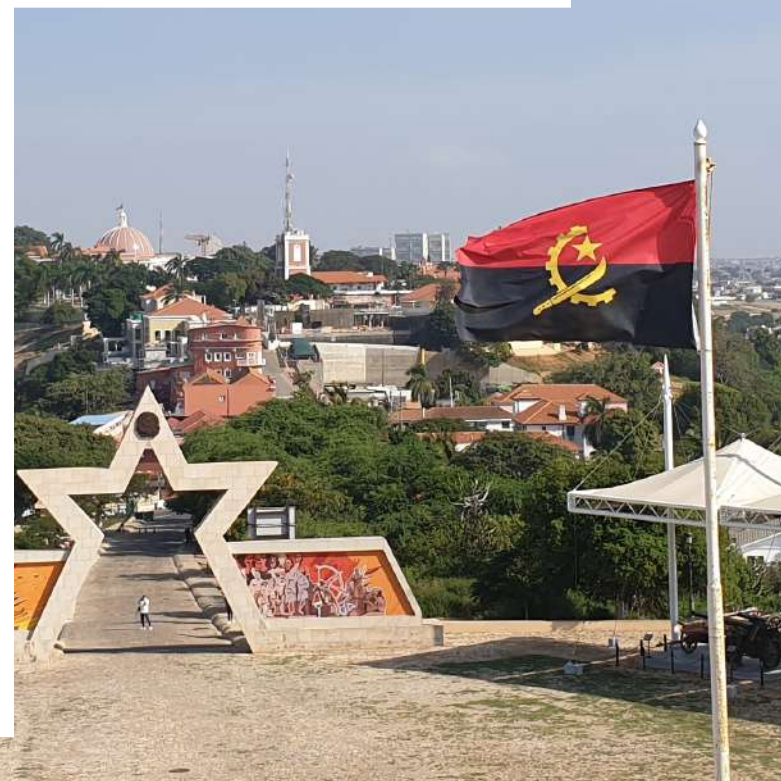

Tour Summary:

Enjoy the drive in Luanda and have a general view of the city, get to know Cacuaco, one of the biggest and most populated districts of Luanda. Stop at city's Ship Graveyard, with its fascinating and scary scenery, and walk up the viewpoint where you'll better see all the 30 ships disintegrating in the sea shore. Stop at the Moon Viewpoint and enjoy its natural Beauty, then get to see and touch it up close to better understand how it's formed.

Have great moments and take a picture next to one of the most iconic trees of Africa, the Baobab tree or as it's called here in Angola the Imbondeiro, in the Golf Course also used by religious groups and churches as place of prayer vigil, worship, where you find gathered a great number of baobab trees, making it a very interesting location. During this tour you will have the opportunity to see various points of the city of Luanda and get an overview of how the city really is.

Pass By: Cacuaco, Cacuaco, Luanda Province

Get to see one of the most populated municipalities of Luanda

Stop At: Ship's Cemetery (Graveyard), Cacuaco, Luanda Angola

Find in Luanda a big graveyard with about 30 ships left to disintegrate in the ocean since the 70s, turning it into a fascinating and scary scenery. Duration: 30 minutes

Stop At: Miradouro da Lua, Luanda Angola

One of the biggest natural attraction of Luanda created by wind and rain erosion, making it a mandatory stop. Duration: 30 minutes

Stop At: Mercado d kikolo panga panga, Panga Panga, Mercado de kikolo, Luanda, Angola

Stop by one of the biggest markets of Angola and get the real local experience. Duration: 10 minutes

Stop At: Palacio de Ferro, Rua Major Kanyangulo, Luanda Angola

Architecture by Gustave Eiffel, the iron palace is now an important tourist attraction in Luanda . Duration: 10 minutes

Stop At: Praia Dos 2 Ilha De Luanda, Ilha De Luanda Em Frente A Marinha Praia, Luanda AO Angola. Enjoy one of the most beautiful and important beaches in Luanda. Duration: 10 minutes

Stop At: Fortaleza de Sao Miguel, Calçada de Sao Miguel, Luanda Angola

The Fortaleza offers a unique view of the city of Luanda and take the opportunity to learn about the history of Angola. Duration: 25 minutes
