Buried City Plymouth Tour

First get the eye-opening facts and see footage from a series of volcanic eruptions compiled in a short 20-minute film at the Volcano Observatory. Then take an exhilarating excursion across the buried Belham River into the uninhabited abandon villages of Cork Hill and surrounding areas, leading to the Buried City Plymouth Zone V, the exclusion zone of Montserrat. Experience first-hand from ground zero, natures wrath on a nation. Disembark on the remains of the old Plymouth Jetty and experience breath taking views of the buried capital and surrounding areas present day with pictorial displays of Montserrat before the Volcano in its glory days. Traverse parts of the Modern day Pompei by foot and witness the devastation of a ravaged city from the direct path of a Volcanic eruption. Finally, drive through a time capsule between the ruins of our modern-day Pompeii creating exhilarating memories to last a lifetime.

Take a short 15-minute bus journey to your starting point and experience the flora and fauna of Montserrat's Centre Hills, on one of our specialists guided Hiking tours. Truly a Nature lover's fantasy!

Experience first-hand the endemic species of Montserrat's wildlife. Get a glimpse of our indigenous National Bird, the Montserrat Oriole, or sights of our rare National Flower, the Heliconia. Immerse yourself in breath taking views of Montserrat from elevated trails above the mainland occupancy. Breathe the freshness of the Montserrat tropical forest and if you're lucky, reap fresh fruits common to Montserrat. Learn about the medicinal uses of the various plants and ancestral methods utilizing local bushes found in the Centre Hills for food consumption and medical purposes. Your Guide is the island's lead Forest Ranger and has over 20 years' experience in the Centre Hill guided tours. He and his team are simply the best and are the most experienced guides you can ask for.

<u>History Tour: Museum, National Trust, and Montserrat Volcano</u> <u>Observatory (MVO)</u>

Learn about Montserrat's ancestral history and the origins of much of its cultural identity. Take a journey in the past with a visit to National Museum as its curators educate you on its pre-colonial past and colonial history.



Then continue with a guided tour of Montserrat to your next destination at the National Trust, where you will take a guided walk through the Trust's Amerindian Gardens of preserved endemic plants. Browse the Trust's Gift shop for local cookbooks, books on Montserrat's endemic birds, intriguing books on Montserrat's history,

Learn about the Montserrat Folklore, its Icons, and National Heroes.



institutions and people by local historian like Sir Professor Howard Fergus or get yourself souvenirs and other memorabilia. Finally journey to the MVO, interact with scientists, and learn how the Volcano devasted and shaped Modern-day Montserrat. Watch a short 20 min interpretation film which unravels the volcano era.

Please Note:

The road to the Observatory is narrow and winding. Driving is on the left-hand side. Persons prone to motion sickness should take the necessary medication prior to the start of the tour. The Observatory has two floors with stairs. Wear comfortable shoes or sandals with rubber soles. The National trust requires an easy walk around the botanical garden. Inclusive of all fees, water, driver & tour guide.

Coastal Kayaking/Snorkelling Tours

After receiving your safety and kayaking instructions and equipment, embark on your "siton-top" ocean kayak and begin your guided kayaking adventure along the north-western coast of Montserrat.

This beautiful volcanic isle is blessed with diverse coral reef, which abounds with interesting and colourful fish and marine life. A short kayak ride along the shorelines will take you to the island's most famous bat caves, which offer a chorus of bat chirps that greet you as you pass the entrance of the caves. Thousands of fruit bats may be seen hanging upside down from the walls and ceilings of the caves and over to the beautiful and secluded, only white sand beach on the island. On arriving at Rendezvous Bay, you will put on your snorkelling gear for a guided snorkelling session, to explore the coral reefs that are home to tropical fish and marine life. Afterwards, have yourself some free time where you can relax and rejuvenate, on the delicate white-sand beach surrounded by crystal clear blue waters.
