

(IE 06) HIKE



Our drive along the picturesque North-West Coast of Trinidad takes us to the busy peninsula of Chaguaramas. Sheltered deep water bays and coves indent this part of the island, where marinas and boat yards offer professional services for boats from all over the world. This area is also a national park and covers 14,572 acres. Our easy hike takes us into the beautiful forest where we admire the tropical flora and fauna and enjoy the

sights and sounds of the tropics. We then continue our hike to the amazing "Bamboo Cathedral", a stretch of approximately 300 meters where the bamboo stalks bend over towards each other forming a canopy above the road. The arches formed above bear a resemblance to those found in a cathedral and have remained unchanged for 150 years. Michel Jean Cazabon, a famous local nineteenth century artist, used the Bamboo Cathedral as the subject of many of his watercolors and in honor of him the route has been named the Cazabon Trail. This hike provides an opportunity for a picturesque, romantic walk for those who enjoy the sights and sounds of nature.

The Abbey welcomes and draws people of all faiths seeking peace, solace, purpose, and fulfillment. Mount Saint Benedict is currently presided over by Abbot John Pereira and houses ten monks.

Begin your tour with an air-conditioned bus ride through the city, passing the striking Parliament building known as the Red House as well as the "Magnificent Seven", a row of imposing colonial houses originally built at the turn of the century as private residences. Continuing around the Queens Park Savannah, you'll make a brief stop at the tropical Botanical Gardens, a cool shady enclave of exotic trees and tropical flowers.

Then it's a short drive to Lady Young Lookout for an excellent panoramic view of Port of Spain. You will then journey to the edge of Trinidad's rain forest to ascend to the monastery, nestled peacefully in the mountains, originally founded by a Brazilian monk as refuge for monks and others suffering religious persecution. At the Seminary your guide will provide a cultural and historical perspective of the monks that have lived the contemplative life for decades. We will visit the beautiful church. Tea and snacks will then be served in the Seminary. As the monastery is completely self-sufficient, you'll savour homemade breads, tea, coffee or fruit juice. We depart for the ship.

DESCRIPTION - CITY HIGHLIGHTS AND - ANGOSTURA RUM DISTILLERY

Following a brief tour of Port of Spain passing all the main points of interest; including the House of Parliament, President's House, Queen's Park Savannah, and a walk through the Botanical Gardens. From here we make our way to the House of Angostura. This is the home of the Famous Angostura Bitters one of Trinidad's signature items used in Mixed Drinks around the world. Angostura is also foremost its rum producers. A guided tour of this distillery takes you through the various stages of the manufacturing processes of two of the Caribbean's finest brands of rum - Fernandes and Old Oak; And of course Angostura Bitters is also manufactured here. The ingredients in the process are a well- guarded secret. At the end of the tour enjoy a sample of the varied blends and rum products produced by the distillery.

Please note the distillery is closed on weekends and public holidays. May open for the tour on a Saturday that is not a public holiday provided that we have reached the maximum.

DESCRIPTION – GASPAREE CAVES ADVENTURE					

Following a short drive to historic Chaguaramas passengers will disembark at the boat yard in Chaguaramas and board a pirogue which will take you to the Gaspar Grande island where we disembark and make our slow walk for approximately 20 minutes to the entrance of the Gasparee Cave – a subterranean system which is 90ft deep and half an acre in size. Arriving at the caves. you will descend through the smaller of two sinkholes to explore this natural wonder – which is filled with fascinating stalagmites, stalactites, flow stones, pillars, ribbons and fringed curtains, and other Limestone features, with names such as Pulpit Pipe Organ, Lovers, Dinosaur Head and others. Inside the cave is a saline pool, 30ft in diameter, its water level fluctuating with the tides, and is home to a few forms of marine life. Natural light fills the cave through a huge sinkhole above the pool, and fills the cave with a heavenly aura. You will then return to the boats for a short ride back to the mainland to board the bus for the port.

(Notes: This tour is not recommended for the inactive individual. The short walk – 20 minute - to the Cave though on concrete pathway, is a continuous uphill climb – about 25-degree incline. This is followed by a descent into the cave - about 100 steps down and back up. The Cave is truly spectacular and for those interested in seeing the wonders of nature, it is a must to visit.)

As the capacity of the cave is limited to 20 pax at one time we will do the 2 departures from the ship if required

The Caroni Nature Sanctuary is a mangrove swamp covering an area of 40 square miles at Trinidad's North West Coast. After 1/2hour drive from Port of Spain we board a large flat-bottomed boat and slowly travel along the beautiful peaceful waterways and lagoons admiring the bizarre Beauty of the Landscape and a variety of birds and other wildlife. The most astounding among these birds is the Scarlet Ibis, a large bright red bird feeding and nesting here. This tour is world renowned among ornithologists as it offers the observer an opportunity to see this rare protected bird with very little effort.

After this relaxing boat ride we return to the main landing and make our way to Port of Spain
