**HALF DAY**

**Dolphins Watching**

**Type:**

Depart from pier. Walk to the boat that will take guests along Golfo Nuevo coasts to watch dolphins in their natural habitat. We sighted the Piedrabuena pier, we crossed the central coast of Puerto Madryn. We border Punta Cuevas (place of the first settlement of Welsh immigrants in our region); there we see the Monument to the Indian Tehuelche and the Ecocentro museum from the sea. We sail observing the Patagonian coasts to the sunken ship, El Folias, in Playa Paraná. Then we go to the area of Punta Loma (First Protected Area of Chubut), a wildlife reserve for Sea Lions and a breeding area for seabirds (cormorants, shearwaters, seagulls, etc.). We continue with the search for dark dolphins in the New Gulf; sighting of them and we return to Puerto Madryn.

**HALF DAY**

**Punta Loma & Estancia San Guillermo**

**Type:**

Travel through the residential area of Puerto Madryn towards Punta Loma Natural Reserve where you will have the opportunity to see a sea lion sanctuary. Young sea lions, which are not sexually mature, may be seen during the entire year, and, from April onwards, you can view the sea lions that migrate from Puerto Piramides. Your tour continues to Estancia San Guillermo, where you will learn about regional flora and view a sheep sheering demonstration. A BBQ will be served prior to departing the ranch.

**Welsh Experience**

**Type:**

Depart from pier and transfer to Gaiman, a small town where Welsh immigrants settled down about a hundred and fifty years ago.

Their descendants still preserve their traditions not only in the evident architect style but also in their religion, music and language.

There, the guests will be able to taste the typical Welsh tea with cakes and sweet tarts, listening to an authentic Welsh choir.

A visit to Bethel chapel re-built in 1913 and the Town Museum with objects of the time of the original settlement.

A few kilometers further away, will show the visitor the local farms.

**PUNTA TOMBO PENGUIN ROOKERY**

**Type:**

Punta Tombo is located approximately 170 miles south of Puerto Madryn and is world renowned as one of the best places to see Magellanic penguins, as it is the largest penguin colony of this species.

From September through April, Punta Tombo hosts approximately one million penguins that arrive to complete their breeding cycle and the molting (change feathers).

Throughout the visit we will have the opportunity to walk among thousands of burrows and marvel at this natural wonder. A box lunch will be provided.

**FULL DAY**

**Península Valdes**

**Type:**

Departure toward Península Valdes, UNESCO World Heritage Site, a privileged wildlife sanctuary.

We drive along the Isthmus Carlos Ameghino, a narrow strip of land connecting the peninsula to the continent, from where the Gulfs Nuevo and San Jose can be observed simultaneously. The first stop is the Visitor Centre, an introduction to the local flora and fauna.

Then we drive to Caleta Valdes, a large inlet home to Southern elephant seals. We continue to the picturesque little town Puerto Piramides to do a City Tour and visit Punta Piramide, a stunning sea-lion rookery.

Finally, we drive back to the pier, on our journey back we may be able to observe Patagonian caviés, guanacos and rhea along the way.

**FULL DAY**

**Peninsula Valdes & San Lorenzo Ranch**

**Type:**

Located roughly 18 Kms from Puerto Madryn is the Peninsula Valdes, one of the finest wildlife reserves in South America. At the entrance to the reserve, the Visitors' Centre has a small exhibit of local fauna and flora. Your adventure continues to Estancia San Lorenzo, located on the extreme north eastern part of Peninsula Valdes to see the famous penguin colony. You will have ample time to see the colony of over 2,000 Magellan penguins including many species of marine birds and flora and fauna from a strategically located bench overlooking the beach. Afterwards, enjoy a traditional Patagonian barbeque. Punta Norte is your final destination. From a cliff viewpoint you'll see an elephant seal and sea lion colony in their natural habitat. This tour not recommended for persons who are pregnant or who have neck or back problems. Flash photos of penguins and and sea lions are not permitted. Please note that not all of the roads are paved and therefore can be quite dusty.
