Corcovado and Sugar Loaf and Churrasco Lunch

Corcovado and Sugar Loaf are among the "must" of any visit to Rio.

The summit of Corcovado will be reached via a cogwheel railway. It is a twenty-minute trip up the Corcovado Mountain. The 709m hunch-backed Corcovado is famous for the giant statue of Christ the Redeemer that stands on the mountain's summit. An amazing attraction is the view... It is as stunning as from Sugar Loaf but offers different perspectives. You will see the beaches of Copacabana, Ipanema and Leblon and the Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon.

Then, proceed for lunch at Assador Barbecue House "A typical Churrascaria".

After lunch, visit Sugar Loaf where you will ascend by a two-stage modern cable car with large windows. At Urca Hill, the city at a closer angle calls the guests to a closer look. Taking the second cable car and another 3 minute ride, the second stage is completed and we are at the summit of the Sugar Loaf. An unsurpassable view welcomes the guests. Now, the Guanabara Bay, the beaches, the Corcovado Statue, the Tijuca Forest, the Niteroi Bridge and the majestic mountain range protecting the city.

After a drive along the beaches of Urca, Botafogo and Flamengo, a brief visit of the historic and modern sections of downtown Rio.

Paço Imperial, built during colonial times to serve as a residence for the Portuguese governors of Brazil, the Cathedral, around the Cinelandia Square there are several landmarks of the Belle Époque of Rio de Janeiro such as the Municipal Theater, National Library among some museums.

Stop at Confeitaria Colombo for a coffee! An alive picture of the Belle Époque in Rio de Janeiro with its famous Belgian mirrors, Jacaranda's furniture, Italian marble is going to show you a never expected Rio de Janeiro. Return by VLT to the pier.

It is a twenty-minute trip up the Corcovado Mountain. The 709m Corcovado statue is listed as one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. It is made of reinforced concrete and soapstone and was constructed between 1922 and 1931. The summit is easily reached by elevator and escalators.


At the top, the imposing Christ Statue and the entire city spread at one's feet.

The Christ the Redeemer statue, also known as Cristo Redentor in Portuguese, is a world-famous landmark. The statue is situated atop the Corcovado Mountain and stands at a towering height of 98 feet (30 meters), with its outstretched arms spanning 92 feet (28 meters).



Access is by cable car, the first leg to the Urca Hill, 220 meters above see level with a beautiful view over Botafogo and Guanabara Bay. The second stage, the top of the Sugar Loaf at a height of 396 meters from where the guests have an uninterrupted view over the bay to Niteroi. The beauty of the sunset can be seen from Urca Hill, with a spectacular panorama of the city's twinkling lights.

An unsurpassable view welcomes the guests. Now, the Guanabara Bay, the beaches, the Corcovado Statue, the Tijuca Forest, the Niteroi Bridge and the majestic mountain range protecting the city.

A hiking trail takes the group to the top of Pedra Bonita (696 m / 2283 ft), one of the most stunning summits of Rio de Janeiro with great views of the city, the coastline and the rain forest around. In a 50 minutes hike going uphill you'll reach the top and see from an unique angle Pedra da Gávea, the famous majestic flat rock that it's like the 'table mountain' in Rio and the biggest monolith close to the ocean in the world (842 m / 2762 ft high). From this summit, in clear days, we can also see the West coast of Rio, the Barra area with its lagoons and mangrove, also Ipanema and Leblon beaches and Dois Irmãos Peaks Hill. The trail goes through Tijuca Rain forest (National Park), one of the largest urban forests in the world with more than 40 km 2 and located in the heart of Rio. On the way up, it may be possible to see some wildlife like toucans, coatis and monkeys. During the tour, discover, the reforestation held in the XIX century and a lot about the flora and the tropical rain forest ecosystem. The tour also includes a visit to another sector of the Tijuca Park, stopping by the Chinese View summit, an amazing belvedere in Rio with views to the Southern side and one of the very few spots in the city where you can get Christ Redeemer, Sugar Loaf, the beach and the lagoon in the same frame.
