Your tour continues to **Blockhouse Ruins** at Shirley Heights where you will view the remains of the Officer's barracks, gun platforms, cisterns and powder magazine where you can enjoy the magnificent view of the surrounding Atlantic Ocean.

Next is a stop at the former signal station, **Shirley Heights Lookout**, which offers a commanding view of the Atlantic Ocean and picture-perfect view of Nelson's Dockyard and English Harbour, this used to be used as a signal station warning of enemy ships approaching.

Your waiting bus then takes you through Antigua's tropical countryside, everyday picturesque village life and calm, rolling hills en route back north through Antiguan villages to St John's and your awaiting ship.



A unique and exclusive opportunity to see Antigua's sister island, Barbuda, which is a wonderful place famed for its deserted pink sand beaches and crystal-clear waters. It is certainly somewhere very few cruise ship passengers will or can claim to have visited in the Caribbean and a fabulous place to visit for the day. Princess Diana used to go every year just to 'chill out'. It's 27 miles north of Antigua and is 62 square miles.

Your starting island, Antigua has much to offer: 108 square miles steeped in history, 365 beaches, harbours and inlets, historical sites, a rainforest and offshore islands. You can enjoy a bird's eye view of this diverse landscape from the comfort of a 6-seat Bell 206 helicopter.

You will be met at the ship by your knowledgeable tour guide and driven to VC Bird International airport or the helipad on Anchorage Road, some 15 minutes away, where you will board your awaiting private helicopter. Your flight will head north out of the airport for the 15 minutes journey across the Caribbean Sea to the awaiting island of Barbuda.

Upon arrival in Barbuda, you will be transferred to your awaiting air-conditioned transfer to be taken for a guided sightseeing tour of Barbuda to include: The Lagoon and the famous Frigate birds (the largest Frigate Bird nesting gathering in the world); Martello Tower, the capital Codrington, Indian Cave, Two Foot Bay and Spanish Point before arriving on one of Barbuda's stunning pink sand beaches and lunch at Nobu Japanese restaurant** followed by a few hours relaxing on a deserted beach.

Transportation will then be waiting to take guests to the airport for the return flight back VC Bird International Airport. Your transportation will be waiting to drive you to the awaiting ship in Antigua.

An air-conditioned taxi ride will take you to the beach with **about 1 mile of white sand**, some fringed in areas by coconut palms and sea grape trees. You will be welcomed for your 5 hours or so stay on the beach with **a refreshing beverage** from the **open bar** upon arrival before being escorted to your complimentary **lounge chair and shared umbrella**, which has been **reserved for you on the beach in a designated area**.

BETTY'S HOPE, DEVIL'S BRIDGE & PARHAM

An amazing tour **with 3 fantastic stops!** Explore Antigua's colourful past and present on a guided tour that travels from the island's quaint northern capital, St John's, through the heart of the island, Antigua's tropical countryside, everyday picturesque village life and calm, rolling hills to **Betty's Hope Sugar Plantation** and its ruins and renovated sugar trains, dramatic **Devil's Bridge** and the impressive historic **Parham**.

Board your air-conditioned transportation with an experienced and knowledgeable Tour Guide. Ride through Antigua's countryside, rich in daily West Indian life, local villages, old churches, that exemplifies West Indian culture, to **Betty's Hope**, a 20 to 25-minute drive out of capital St John's.

Built in 1674 by Sir Christopher Codrington, this was the site of one of the first full-scale sugar plantations on Antigua. It remained in the Codrington Estate until the 1920s. Betty's Hope is located just south of Pares Village. For more than 300 years, this prominent sugar plantation, located on the eastern side of the island, has played a leading role in, and influenced the lives of many generations of Antiguan. **This is the only twin sugar mill, standing side by side in the Eastern Caribbean** and has **several renovated sugar trains** used to transport sugar cane across the island to view and photograph.

Your tour continues to **Devil's Bridge**. For hundreds of thousands of years, the Atlantic's waves have crashed into the east coast of Antigua creating a natural arch, or bridge. Numerous geysers and blowholes surround the arch as waves continually break against the coastal rocks.

In addition to being a natural phenomenon, **Devil's Bridge** also holds cultural importance in Antiguan history. A prehistoric, Amerindian site is located within its vicinity and suggests that prehistoric peoples may have used the area for fishing and settlement. Popular belief suggests slaves leapt to their death off of the natural arch during the period of slavery in Antigua. **Devil's Bridge** gets its name from these myths as the stories contend the devil claimed those who leapt off the bridge.

Your final stop is **Parham**, Antigua's oldest town (established in 1632), which boasts an impressive history having been the centre of Antigua's sea-borne trade for almost 200 years. Beginning around 1700, Antigua's sugar industry became the focus of activity in Parham making it a thriving civic and trading metropolis of its day.

Here is **St Peter's Anglican church**, an architectural masterpiece, a 'gem waiting to be discovered', built in 1840 and featuring a ribbed wooden ceiling and stucco walls. The roof is reputed to be the framework of a slave's ship.

You will see the **Emancipation bell**, reputedly rung to signify the end of emancipation. It is now used to announce the start of church on Sunday mornings, for funerals and for weddings, as well as on old year's night, at midnight, signaling the end of the old year and the beginning of the new.

Your transportation will then take the journey back into St John's and your awaiting ship.

THE BIRD'S NEST ECO TOUR

After being met on the pier by our friendly, experienced Tour Guide, you will then board your air-conditioned transportation and be taken for a scenic drive to Shell Beach, some 15 minutes away.

Here your awaiting boat will take you on enjoyable boat ride through North Sound islands and mangroves en-route to Great Bird Island, one of Antigua's best locations for snorkelling. Great Bird Island is a 20-acre islet lying almost three kilometres north-east of Antigua. Visitors to Great Bird Island regard it as a '*desert island*' dream.

Named by sailors who were amazed at the number of birds that they found living and nesting there, Great Bird Island is a miniature paradise. White sand beaches at either end of the sandbar are the main attraction for visitors.

You will be given a tuition in snorkelling before you are invited to put on your mask, fins and buoyancy belt and go snorkelling accompanied with expert guides in the crystal-clear waters! Or you can simply take a swim or relax and soak up the sun in the idyllic location on the beach.

We will hike up the hilltop trail to wonderful views of outlying islands and Antigua. It's ideal for looking for the migrating whales during December to May, sea turtles, and many varieties of birds who nest here throughout the year. Bring some binoculars!

Whilst it is better known for its two superb beaches, (where you can relax and top up your tan), and closely surrounding coral reefs, it is also the only place you may be able to see an *Antiguan Racer* snake in the wild. (They are only 20 cms long at best, non-venomous and completely harmless). It's also the home for a variety of endangered creatures including exotic red-billed tropic birds, brown pelican, rare lizards, West Indian whistling ducks and the magnificent frigate bird or man o' war bird. An eco-island paradise!!

A delicious Caribbean lunch of barbequed chicken, pasta, green salad with local banana bread for dessert, soft drink, water and rum punch will be served on the beach.

Suitably relaxed and educated, your boat will return you to Shell Beach before returning by road to your ship.

Don't forget your sun protection, towel, swimsuit and, of course, a camera and binoculars!



ANTIGUA CANOPY TOUR

*The Antigua Canopy Tour is a unique, award winning eco-tour through Antigua's lush rainforest, where you embark on an **unforgettable 17 element journey** through the verdant forest, high above the trees. You will be met at your ship and taken by air-conditioned taxi to the Antigua rainforest some 40 minutes away. After being briefed by fully trained and experienced guides your exhilarating tour can begin.*

The tour offers uncompromised safety on a complete double wire throughout with a Double Redundant system. Your state of the art harness and safety helmet are from the world's leaders in challenge course equipment. All our Rangers have attended, passed and annually assessed by the most stringent training programme conducted by the ACCT, world leaders for Challenge Course standards in installation, operation and inspection.

After a welcome local drink, the excitement starts at the Old Pump House with a walk over a suspension bridge from the side of the building, which spans the gorge to the far bank. Once across the bridge, there is a **12-zip lines** journey through the forest which begins as you trail to the start aerial zips, criss-crossing the gorge. There are zip lines of 52 feet to 328 feet in length. The geography of the gorge dictates that you are above the treetops for large parts of the run – entering a corridor in the foliage at either end. **In total there are a series of 12 zip lines, 3 aerial walkways and 2 suspension bridges**, giving a bird's eye view of the flora and fauna in the rainforest whilst listening to the numerous bird species.

You will have some short trails into the gorge and then a series of connecting zip lines and bridges, which criss-cross the gorge at tree canopy level. The gorge is full of interesting plants and fruits and has a definite 'tropical' feel to it. Within the gorge there is a series of large trees (incl the silk cotton, one of Antigua's National Symbols), prominent boulders, shaded areas with interesting plant-life, a range of wild fruits, vines, mosses and lichens.

Guests are also offered complimentary water on the course and a certificate of bravery upon completion of the tour.

This tour is not recommended for pregnant women, persons with a history of heart conditions, seizures, back, knee or shoulder problems or other pre-existing health problems. Maximum weight 235 lbs; minimum height 4 feet. Participants should not wear strapless shoes or strapless sandals and ladies should wear shorts or long pants. A change of shirt is recommended.
