Leaving ship, board onto tender boats to reach Athinios port. From that point, ascend your motorcoach to Pyrgos Village. A Hidden Gem of Santorini and the best-preserved medieval settlement on the highest point of the island, the village of Pyrgos retains an unruffled grace of a picturesque Greek village of yesteryear. Pyrgos, is the largest preserved village on Santorini and the island's former capital. Strategically built in the heart of the pre-volcanic hinterland and at the foot of Mt Profitis Ilias, this village offers magnificent panoramic views. For your lunch stop, head straight to island's capital, Fira town, to enjoy a great hospitality and gastronomic experience at Marinera restaurant that combines authentic tastes from Santorini and the Mediterranean. Level up your gastronomical journey in one of the best places to enjoy the famous sunset while savoring delicacies inspired by Santorinian and Greek cuisine. Santorini's beautiful capital 'Fira' town is the biggest and most cosmopolitan settlement of Santorini. Located in the western edge of the island, opposite the volcano and the two volcanic islands, Palaia Kammeni and Nea Kammeni, Fira town is a combination of natural beauty, social life, night life and shopping, where all the action takes place. Fira's views leave visitors speechless at any time of the day. Afterwards, you can enjoy your free time at Fira and join the cable car (ticket provided) to the old port.
