TOUR DESCRIPTION:

Jews, Christians, and Muslims – they all hold this place dear. Sights here represent each of the faiths. Kicking things off is a fly-by driving tour, passing the Israeli parliament building known as the Knesset, the Museum of Israel and the Shrine of the Book. It's the best way to see the city sights. Next you'll drive to the top of the Mount of Olives. Named after its olive tree-planted slopes, this place is thought to be where the dead will be resurrected on Judgement Day. The views from here are epic. From here, you'll head for the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus went to pray after the Last Supper and was betrayed by his disciple Judas. A visit to the Church of All Nations is also on the itinerary here. It's followed by a walk through the old city following the path Jesus took as he carried his cross to Calvary, a visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the site of Jesus' crucifixion, burial and resurrection and a glimpse of the shimmering mosques of Al-Aqsa and The Dome of the Rock. You'll also stop off





at the Western Wall, the place where Orthodox Jews nod in prayer and put prayer notes into the cracks of the wall. Finally, you'll head to Bethlehem after lunch in a restaurant, and to see one of Christianity's most sacred sights – the Church of the Nativity. Built on the same site as the stable where Mary gave birth to Jesus

Leaving the Old City through Jaffa Gate you'll head to your lunch with time to relax.

Re-joining your bus you'll head to Mt Zion where you'll visit David Tomb, the Last Supper room and the Dormition Church, before getting back to the Old City through Zion Gate to visit the Jewish Quarter and it sites: the Cardo, the Broad Wall, the Markets Roof Vista and more...

To end your day, relax and take a fly-by driving tour of the city. Highlights seen include the Knesset where Israel's Parliament holds court and the Israel Museum where the world's oldest-known biblical documents, the Dead Sea Scrolls, are kept, before heading back to the hotel.





TOUR DESCRIPTION:

Your journey to the park will take you past the Valley of Elah, scene of the famous battle between David and Goliath, to Beit Guvrin. Referred to by Josephus Flavius as one of the most important towns taken by the Romans in 68 CE, this once small village grew in importance. Your visit to the town is highlighted by a guided walk through the amazing caves, which have been used as cisterns, animal pens, burial grounds, pigeon housing and for oil production. Some caves served as churches, as evidenced by the crosses that can still be seen carved on the walls. The columbarium, or the niche that holds the funeral urn, is not only one of the most spectacular of its type, it is also one of the oddest. A few feet above eye level are hundreds of small alcoves, where pigeons were kept in ancient times.

For another glimpse into centuries' past, view a remarkable ancient olive press and visit the Sidonian Burial Cave, the only cave in the area that is beautifully restored and boasts interior decorative paint.

Finally, enter the enormous bell caves. Dug between the 7th and 10th centuries, the spacious caves might remind you of a cathedral or large concert hall, complete with superior acoustics.

You will then head off for a visit in a local winery. After tasting some Israeli wines you will board your coach and return to the ship.
