## **FULL DAY TOUR VALPARAISO, VIÑA DEL MAR AND CASABLANCA VALLEY FROM VALPARAISO CRUISE PORT**



Enjoy the colorful sights during this full-day guided tour of Valparaíso and Viña del Mar. Stroll through the hills and see the murals and urban art displayed there. Get to know Viña del Mar and fishing, do a wine tasting in Casablanca Valley.

### **Highlights of the tour:**

On this tour you can visit the historic city of Valparaíso, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, leaving from the cruise port.

In Valparaíso you will walk through its streets on one of its steep hills, and marvel at the unique view from its points of view towards the vastness of the Pacific Ocean. You will appreciate the color of its houses, stairs and beautiful murals everywhere and you will get on an old funicular from the 19th century, you will also know the port to see its bustling activity and then visit the picturesque city of Viña Del Mar to choose a good restaurant of food with local products at lunch time.

Finally, you will visit a beautiful vineyard in Casablanca Valley, for a wine tasting (no tour, included in the tour price), ending in the cruise port before 5:00 pm.

1. You'll get picked up
2. Pass by Ruta 68
3. Casablanca valley – Stop 1 hour Wine tasting (no tour) and visit to the facilities in a local vineyard.
4. Plaza Sotomayor – Stop 15 minutes. Main square of the city of Valparaíso, where the General Command of the Chilean Navy is located, a few steps from the Prat Pier and the Monument to the Heroes of the Chilean Navy.
5. Prat Pier – Stop 15 minutes. Here you can see part of the cruise terminal, some merchant ships, the giant cranes, boats on the bay, etc.
6. Caleta Portales – Stop 30 minutes. Local fish and seafood market, observation of boats, fishing activity, sea products, birds, sea lions, etc.
7. Cerro Alegre – Stop 75 minutes. To walk along the Hill to see the viewpoints to the



Pacific Ocean, the colorful houses and the murals that adorn every corner of the place.

8. Avenida Perú – Stop 20 minutes. In this place you will look for a restaurant for lunch typical Chilean food, like local fish and seafood (on your own).
9. Corporación Museo de Arqueología e Historia Francisco Fonk – Stop 20 minutes. We stop in front of the Fonk Museum to see an original sculpture of Easter Island (Moai)
10. You'll return to the starting point.

## DISCOVER VALPARAISO AND VIÑA DEL MAR IN A 6 HOURS (INCLUDES REÑACA GARDEN CITY)



Tour the beautiful city of Valparaíso and discover its spectacular views of the Pacific Ocean, its mural art and graffiti in an incredible walk through the neighborhoods (called hills): Cerro Alegre, Cerro Concepción, Paseo Atkinson, Gervasoni, etc. Then, the charming city-garden of Viña del Mar and finally appreciate the waterfront

and the town of Reñaca in 6 hours of travel.

### Highlights of the tour:

Start this tour in direction to the Alegre and Concepción hills, to walk of more than an hour through the colorful streets, to see mural art, stairs everywhere, incredible views and later, descend using the old local transport for 19th Century, the funicular. Continue with a visit to the sea food and fish market, Caleta Portales, there the sea lions are an attraction, in addition to Viña del Mar, known as the Garden city, where you can observe an original sculpture of Easter Island, a Moai. Then, the vehicle will take you to Avda. Perú and Reñaca to photograph the Pacific coast and some of its castles and beautiful constructions.

Finally you will return to the cruise port of Valparaíso.

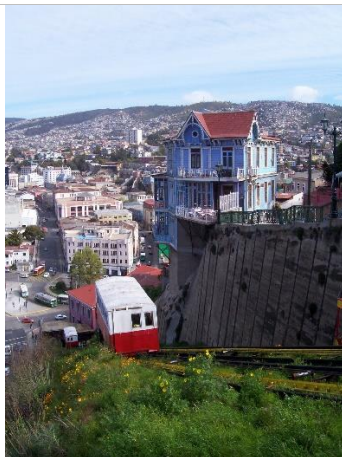

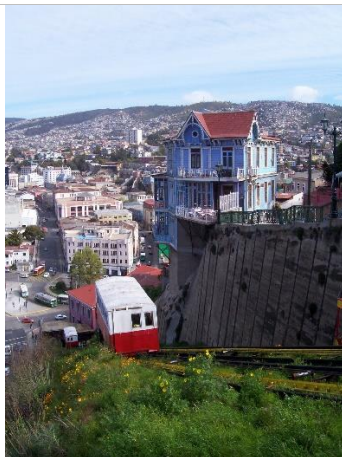

<b>Description:</b>	<p><i>Departure from the pier, we will explore the Casablanca Wine Valley, which is well-known for its cool climate varieties due to the cooling effect of the Humboldt current that runs along the coast of Chile. We will be able to taste the classics of this genre, such as Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, or Syrah, as well as learn about viticulture in general, and the advantages and challenges of grape growing in Chile.</i></p> <p><i>Leaving the port behind, we will drive deep into the Casablanca Valley to visit Casa Valle Viñamar and Casas del Bosque Winery. At each winery we will be taken to the production areas, have time to stroll around the winery grounds, and taste a range of fine wines from that producer. We will have some time to shop in each winery.</i></p> <p><i>In between both wineries, we will drive through Casablanca town, stopping at the main square to get to know the important buildings here as well the idiosyncrasy of this town.</i></p> <p><i>Return to pier.</i></p>
